HIGH JINKS AT BATH BEACH.

Some of the residents of Bath Beach and Basonhurst, New York, are shocked at the doings of others, including members of the summer colony, who make common practice these warm days of parading about the streets in bathing suits. The costumes worn by some of the bathers are rather gaudy and scant. Women who wear their mingle with men in similar attire and cut up capers that cause their neighbors to blush. Many of the women who put on bathing suits seldom enter the water, it is said. Wednesday afternoon several young women in flashy bathing suits were seen spinning along on their bicycles in Croseye avenue and two others were noticed in a light wagon. A dozen or more women were also seen frolicking about Basonhurst Park. The women as a rule put on the bathing suits at home or in boarding houses and many of them walk about until after nightfall.

A Brooklyn magistrate, who lived in Basonhurst for some time, said last night: "The scenes enacted by these women and their parading around in bathing costumes are becoming so common that I would not be surprised to see all semblance of decency left behind in the city when the summer colony comes to Bath Beach and Basonhurst. Their actions are disgraceful."

A resident, whose home is opposite Basonhurst Park, said: "The women here this summer are acting in a way that would make their blush were they to do the same thing in the city. They seem to have lost all modesty. Matters have reached such a state that it is unfit for my wife and daughter to walk through the streets. It is impossible now even to enjoy the comforts of our piazza."

Other residents say that the bathing suit women drink cocktails from morning till midnight, and that many of them have the high-kicking habit.

STEEP STORIES FROM THE ORIENT.

A remarkable story was brought to Vancouver, B. C., by the steamer Empress of Japan recently to the effect that a number of Russian ex-officers and privates from Siberia had joined the ranks of the boxers, and that, having reason to suspect the fidelity of their Chinese transport coolies, the Russians had killed 200 of the Chinese and then loaded their bodies into a junk which they set on fire and set drifting down the Pei Ho. The story is published with a number of corroborative details in several Oriental papers.

Many Chinese now aver that Prince Tuan, the rebel elder, is not a member of the imperial clan at all. He is supposed to be the son of the fifth Prince Tuan, but it is alleged that he is a supposititious son, his mother being a nurse in Prince Tuan's family. By collusion with Prince Tuan's wife the child who is now Prince Tuan was introduced as the Princess's son.

Arrivals from Tientsin by the steamer Empress of Japan say that Seeburg, an American, of Tientsin, essayed to carry dispatches through to Tientsin. He went down in a customs launch which was ambushed, and he and seven blue-jackets were chased across country until they reached the Russian camp.

An American officer of Seymour's column is reported to have stated to his return to Tientsin that there was more arms and ammunition of war in Hsi Kiu ar-ena, captured by Seymour, than in the whole of the United States.

According to news received by the Empress one European who was serving the Chinese was killed in the recent fighting at Tientsin, and two men, supposed to be Frenchmen, have been taken prisoners by the allied forces.
