MISCELLANEOUS.

Rev. William Booth, commander-in-chief of the Salvation Army, will come to America toward the end of September for a four month tour of the country.

Robert Stanley, a cigar maker, who shot his wife in a drunken frenzy at Binghamton, N. Y., on Wednesday and who was captured Thursday morning was found dead in his cell Thursday night. It is thought he died from arsenical poisoning.

The Newport yacht racing association has invited Thomas W. Lawson to bring Independence there and race with Constitution and Columbia for the trophy the association has offered. Mr. Lawson has replied that all depends on the action the New York Yacht Club take.

It is announced that ex-Senator Towne, of Minnesota; Gov. McMillan, of Texas, and ex-Governor Hogg, are members of a company being organized to develop the holdings in the Beaumont, Tex. oil field on an extensive scale. The capital stock will be \$5,000,000.

Owing to the difficulty of the Russian railway in obtaining a delivery for Russian-made rails and other material, the government has decided to allow, when necessary, the ordering of such material abroad. This removal of the diet prohibiting the purchase of steel material abroad makes an opening for the American trade.

Emperor Franz Josef, of Austria, will start on his trip to Bohemia on June 15. The greatest care has been taken in planning the Emperor's visit, that neither the Germans nor the Czechs in Bohemia be offended. I. has been arranged that at Prague the burgomaster deliver his address of greeting in both languages. Similar precautions will be taken at Aussig to avoid the least friction.

The practice of selling horse flesh for consumption has become so awfully widespread among Paris butchers that the board of health is taking steps to build a slaughter house where horses alone will be admitted. In this way all animals can be subjected to a rigorous physical examination. It is to the inferior class of horses, and not to the principle of eating horse flesh that the board of health objects.

What promises to be of great value to mariners of the Atlantic is the daily publication, issued Thursday for the first time, from the naval hydrographic office in Washington. It is a report of wrecks, logs and journals in the North Atlantic. It will be mailed every night at 10 o'clock, to Boston, New York, Philadelphia, Baltimore, Norfolk and Savannah and thence made public through the branch offices. Formerly only weekly bulletins have been issued.

The new prison commutation law in Pennsylvania gives the board of pardons the power to commute sentence of convicts as much as five months during the fifth year of penal servitude. Attorney General Knox is of the opinion that this power, if applied to government prisoners, would be virtually an exercise of executive clemency and that it would not be fair to other government prisoners, in the new Atlantic, U. 
