TO DEMAND AN INQUIRY. Rear Admiral Winfield Scott Schley will demand a court of inquiry and will also bring civil suit against the publisher of Edgar Stanton Macley's "History of the United States Navy."

Capt. Charles E. Clark, who commanded the Oregon in the Santiago fight, was shown an interview in which he was quoted as having said the Brooklyn was struck by more projectiles than all the other ships put together during the Santiago battle.

The Brooklyn was in the worst of it and fought a battle to the credit of her commander and his men. Admiral Evans was opened the port. He has forced an investigation in justice to both men.

By American naval officers he is regarded as being friendly to Sampson by his temperate language in Macley's book on which he is said to be openly charged to Schley, was too much for "Fighting Bob" to endure, and at a risk, of the displeasure of Secretary Long and the President he has sought to ring about a definite end of the whole affair.

THE CONVENTION.

The committee on education of the constitutional convention has decided to report against dividing the public school fund between the two races in proportion to the taxes paid by each.

This means that the negroes will not be deprived of educational facilities. The suffrage convention yesterday adopted a motion by Col. Smith, of Alexandria, providing for a sub-committee (Senator Daniel to be chairman) to prepare as soon as practicable a franchise clause for submission to the convention.

A resolution was adopted to appropriate \$500,000 for the erection of a new penitentiary.

Mr. Caspman offered a resolution providing that only one commissioner of revenue shall be elected in each county, shall not succeed himself, and that his list of property assessed for taxation shall be posted in each magisterial district in the county. The commissioners are to receive salaries and to be elected for a term of four years.

Delegate Pettit, of Fluvanna, presented the report of the minority on preamble and bill of rights. The minority report is the Mason bill of rights in its entirety, objection being made on all amendments recommended by the majority. The report was laid on the table and ordered printed.

DIED FROM HIS WOUND.—Robert Lilly, chief of police at Elkins, W. Va., for shooting whom William Brooks, colored, was lynched Monday night, died last night from his wound.

The negro woman with Brooks also shot Lilly. Angry citizens are looking for her, and she will meet a similar fate to that of Brooks if caught. The woman is believed to be hiding among the negro railroad construction shanties south of Elkins. The negroes are terrorized and are giving Elkins a w-e-o-berb. Armed citizens patrolled the town yesterday in anticipation of an attack by the 500 negroes in camp. Brooks' body hung from a tree in the park under an arc light from 8 o'clock Monday night until noon yesterday. Thousands of people, including women and children, viewed it. The mob made no attempt at concealment. It was not at first known that Lilly, after being shot, himself, had shot the negro four times.
