ELOPEMENT RECALLED.

Mrs. Clara A. Riedel, who figured in an elopement that attracted considerable attention locally several months ago, and who is now a resident of Catonsville, has instituted proceedings in the Supreme Court of the District of Columbia against Carlton B. Hazard, asking the court to require the latter to disincumber certain of her property from the effect and operation of a mortgage imposed upon her by him, or to account to her for the proceeds of the mortgage. It is explained by Mrs. Riedel that last June, being the owner of certain lands in Virginia and being about to absent herself from that State, she conveyed the real estate and personal property thereon to the defendant.

It is added that simultaneously with the conveyance to the defendant executed two declarations of trust, the fact being that the conveyances, though separate and distinct, were simply for the purpose of countervailing him the trustee or agent of the complainant, to raise upon the security of the real estate a loan of \$5,000 for the complainant.

Mrs. Riedel goes on to say that subsequently, finding she would not require the money, she notified Mr. Hazard to that effect. She eventually obtained an admission from him, she says, that he had made a mortgage, but he did not remit to her any of it proceeds. Later, she says, she submitted a grossly excessive demand for allowances to himself out of the fund as the condition upon which he would account to her for the proceeds of the loan.

Among other things, so the court is informed, the defendant claimed three per cent each, aggregating \$750, for negotiating the loan, in addition to various items of alleged expenses in taking parties to see the farm, railroad fares, telegrams and the like.

On objection, it is stated, Mr. Hazard took back the bill, and submitted a second statement, from which it appears that he still claims two commissions of \$200 for negotiating the loan; \$250 to himself for alleged services in connection with a bill in equity and the guardianship of the complainant's children; an item of \$1,000 as commission on sale or exchange of the complainant's farm, although no sale or exchange has ever been effected, and numerous minor charges.

Mrs. Riedel announces that she gravely needs the aid of the court in separating her from a spoliator on the hands of Mr. Hazard and in requiring him to remove the incumbrance, which, it is alleged, he has unlawfully created upon her property; or, if he is unable to do this, in requiring him to account to her for its proceeds, and to indemnify her against the interest charges and other expenses to which she may be subjected by reason of his unauthorised and improper conduct.

A lady J. J. Darrington represents Mrs. Riedel. On June 8 of last year Col. W. A. Simpson, chief of the military information division of the War Department, reported that William Morey, married, and the father of five small children, and Mrs. Clara Riedel, a widow with two children, employed as an interpreter in the same division, had been absent without leave for a week. A letter before that time from Morey had received a note from her husband which read: "I am going to leave you forever. I will see that you get \$100 a month during your life, enough for you and the children. You can do what you please about the woman in the case."

It was given out that Mrs. Riedel had sold her beautiful country home near Alexandria, the old Dangerfield estate, to C. B. Hazard, a real estate dealer of Washington, \$20,000. From the date of that transaction she had not been seen at her previous lodgings, which were an apartment building in U Street. Mr. Hazard said at the time that he had bought the farm with the stocks, furniture and all appurtenances. The farm had been leased to a family with whom Mrs. Riedel's two children lived, and when she sold the place she incidentally asked Mr. Hazard to please look after the children, a son twelve years old and a daughter eight years old. Mr. Hazard said that she impressed him that she was to be absent only temporarily.

Mr. Hazard put himself in communication with Mrs. Atterton, Mrs. Riedel's mother, of Newark, Ohio, who is a widow of the late Representative W. Atterton and who subsequently took charge of the children.

There was little surprise expressed at the sudden and abrupt departure of Mrs. Riedel and Morey at the time by those who had observed the intimacy of their relations. It was said that Morey had not been going home nights for some time, reporting to his wife that he was doing some government work at Indian Head.

It was also said that Mrs. Riedel's actions at her lodgings had been such as to compel the managers of the place to give her warning to leave.

Mrs. Riedel is about forty-four years old, is small of stature and was not considered possessing any appearance. She was, however, a linguist of considerable ability, by means of which she held her position in the War Department.

About fourteen years ago, while her family was travelling in Switzerland, she met and married Mr. Riedel. Upon their return to this country Mrs. Atterton bought for them the beautiful country seat of Dangerfield, about fifteen miles south of Washington. Four years ago Mr. Riedel died and Mrs. Riedel came to Washington to live, leaving her children to the care of the servants down on the farm.
