Anti-Saloon League.

The fourth annual convention of the Anti-Saloon League of Virginia convened last night at Centenary Methodist Church in Lynchburg. It will be in session until Thursday night. The address of welcome was delivered by Rev. D. G. C. Butts, the convention church pastor, and the response was by Dr. John Hannon, of Danville. The annual address of the president, Rev. James Gannon, was followed by an address by Rev. G. W. Young, superintendent of the Kentucky League.

The school of methods, in which prominent temperance workers of the State participated, consumed the morning and afternoon, though it is not really a part of the convention proper. The feature of this school was a paper by Rev. J. W. West, field secretary, which was in the form of a report of a ways and means committee. The changes in the State laws as suggested by the speaker are, in brief, as follows:

First—Impose a jail sentence in addition to fine for violation of local option laws. In addition a \$500 bond to be required and increased \$500 with each conviction.

Second—a search-warrant law to be enacted to find liquor secreted in local option territory which shall be prima facie evidence of violation of law.

Third—Sales by distillers to be prohibited in local option territory.

Fourth—An anti-jug and package law enacted similar to that in other States.

Fifth—Common carriers to be prohibited from delivering liquors consigned to fictitious addresses in local option territory.

Sixth—A law impeaching officers who fail to enforce law by petition of a majority of qualified voters in their jurisdiction.

Seventh—For prohibiting selling to habitual drunkards and for the extermination of free-lunch privileges where license is granted.

Eighth—All saloons to be closed from 11 p. m. to 6 a. m.

Ninth—A plain local option ballot to be provided.

Tenth—Impartial judges of election to be appointed, three by the court, three by each contesting interest.

The paper was referred to a special committee for detailed report at a later session.

Already more than a hundred delegates are registered from all sections of the State.

The Disabled Russian Ships.

An account of the condition of the Russian ships in Port Arthur harbor follows:

The Sevastopol is sunk in 150 feet of water and cannot be raised. The Retvizan is terribly damaged above and below. The superstructure was riddled by shell fire, and the turrets blown up. The deck is visible low tide. The Pobieda has a heavy list to starboard, and is much damaged below and burnt above. The Retvizan and the Pobieda suffered more than any of the other ships. They appear to be unfit for further use. The Peresvelt is slightly damaged below. The superstructure and funnels are much injured and the fighting tops are gone. The Poltava is the least damaged, both above and below. The latter two vessels can easily be refloated. The Pallada and Bayan are apparently not seriously damaged and can be refloated.

With the exception of the Retvizan the ships were not much damaged by shell fire. The main armor has hardly been pierced, and the conning towers are intact except where burnt and where howitzer shells inflicted some slight damage. Three days before the capitulation the ships were set on fire with kerosene, and mines exploded alongside them.

To sum up, the Peresvelt, Poltava, Pallada and Bayan may be saved at great expense, but the difficulties will be very great, as there is no dock for battleships. The Retvizan is considered hopeless and the Pobieda doubtful.

The turret guns were all destroyed by explosion before the surrender. Some of the guns of the secondary armament are intact. Most of the small guns were removed to forts. The exact damage to the engines has not been ascertained.

Russians state the fleet was unfit for service after the engagement of August 10. Coal was abundant and was used to protect the decks against howitzer fire. On the capture of Rojushan the ships were sunk by opening their sluices in order to protect them from Japanese fire.

Tokio Suspects a Scheme.

The note of the Russian government to the powers, calling attention to the alleged violation by China of her declared neutrality, which Russia charges has been at the instance of Japan; the raid of Lieutenant-General Mitchenko's cavalry southwest of Liaoyang, resulting, as the Japanese allege, in the deliberate invasion neutral territory, and the alleged violation of French neutrality by vessels of the Russian second Pacific squadron in making a prolonged stay at ports of Madagascar, have created the impression in Japanese official quarters that the Russians are trying to involve France, China and other powers so that Russia may be enabled to take her defeat with better grace.

A prominent official said: "I cannot believe that sane Frenchmen will be seriously influenced by the documents alleged to have been prepared by General Kodama, showing a plan of campaign for a Japanese invasion of French Indo-China, which are forgeries. If it should be Russia's scheme first to embroil France with China, it would be more easily understood than to provoke England alone, which act would not bring assurance of French support."
