Drowning Accident. One of the prettiest young girls of Richmond and one of the city's most promising young men were drowned while on a launch party down the James river Thursday night.

The naphtha launch Charlotte carried a merry party down the river, consisting of Miss Rosa Satterfield, her mother, Mrs. Calvin Satterfield, as chaperone; Miss May Satterfield, of Louisville; Miss Edna Wright, of New Jersey, and Miss Annis Clarke, all the girls at a house party of Miss Satterfield.

The young men, besides young Gordon, were Cabell Fitzgerald, John Hobson, of Powhatan; Herbert Whitehurst and Nelson Robins, the latter being host of the occasion, having arranged the trip in honor of Miss Satterfield and her guests.

Miss Clarke was saved by grasping a pillow thrown to her, and was hauled aboard with difficulty. Miss Satterfield and Mr. Gordon were not seen again, either having been stunned by the shock or completely overcome by the heavy waves.

Calvin Satterfield was recently attracted to Philadelphia by the offer of an important position there, and intended soon to carry his family to that city. Mrs. Satterfield is the daughter of the late Gen. Lindsay Walker, and sister of Superintendent C. C. Walker, of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway.

Young Gordon, known to all his friends as Jack, was a favorite. The bodies have not been recovered.

Murderer Hanged. Three negroes were hanged in Virginia yesterday for murder. Andrew J. Davenport, who murdered Willie Thomas January 29, 1906, paid the penalty in the city jail at Newport News.

The hanging at Newport News occurred at sunrise. Although Davenport dropped a distance of eight feet, his neck was not broken and he died from strangulation, it being 14 minutes after the drop of the trap before life was extinct.
