New Norfolk Line. It is now said that the new line which will run steamers daily between the Jamestown Exposition, Norfolk, Alexandria and Washington has bought the steamers City of Worcester and C. H. Northam, of the New England Navigation Company, and the Dreamland, of the Iron Steamboat Company.

Fugitive Captured. The negro who was suspected of stealing a stove Wednesday night and who broke away from Officer Sherwood and escaped, was captured last night by Officer Henderson in a saloon in the northern section of the city.

A Variety of Weather. There was a variety of weather last night—rain, sleet, thunder and lightning. After the snowfall had ceased yesterday, the wind blew cold and raw from the southeast and the heavens continued threatening.

Begin the Campaign. The first meeting on the stump of candidates for the democratic congressional nomination in the Eighth district took place yesterday at King George Court House.

Death of a Contractor. Joseph A. Kuswell, of Raby, Fairfax county, died at his residence on Thursday morning at 8:30 o'clock.

Designed by Miss Clements. Miss Ruth Clements, daughter of Mr. James E. Clements, superintendent of public schools in Alexandria county, has designed a beautiful poster for the Southern Railway, representing the landing of Captain John Smith and his companions at Jamestown Island.

Night School. The night school under the auspices of the W. C. T. U. is being held on Tuesday and Friday evenings each week in Christ Church Parish Hall.

School Board.

At the monthly meeting of the City School Board, held last night, there were present: Capt. Herbert Bryant, chairman, and Messrs. Thompson, Stabler, Yates, Ramsey, Thompson, Bradshaw, Carne and the Superintendent.

The clerk reported that the request made to the City Council for appropriation of \$100 to defray the expenses of an educational exhibit at the Jamestown Exposition had been complied with.

Mr. Yates reported that slight repairs to one of the furnaces in Washington building had been made at small cost; also that a floor in Seaton building needed repairs; this work, however, could be deferred till the summer recess.

In response to the application of a teacher for increased pay Mr. Thomson reported that the finance committee could not recommend any increase during the present session.

The Superintendent reported that the State Board of Examiners would hold their next meeting in this city commencing on Monday next and continuing during the week, and at their request there would be a teacher's institute on Friday, the 15th inst.

The teachers of Alexandria and Fairfax counties would be present and he would give the city teachers holiday on that day in order that they might attend the institute. He had secured Odd Fellows Hall for the meeting and the Fairfax school trustees had appropriated \$300 toward the expense of the meeting and had requested this board to pay for the rent of the hall, etc.

The Superintendent stated that on Friday night, the 15th, there would be a public meeting in the Baptist Church, to which the members of the board had been invited; several addresses would be made and an interesting program, with music, would be carried out. The examiners would be among those who would make addresses.

The chairman stated that he had received a letter from Mr. Maphis, the examiner for this district, who had expressed the hope that the members of the board would attend the meeting and make addresses.

An appropriation to pay for the necessary expenses attending the meeting was made.

The Superintendent also stated that his attention had been called by residents of the neighborhood to the disorderly behavior of the boys going to and from school. He said he had been told that the conduct of the white boys was more reprehensible than that of the colored boys, as the former seemed to bring about the various collisions which occur between them.

Several members expressed their views concerning the bad behavior of the school boys on the street and it was the consensus of opinion that the police authorities should take the matter in hand and make examples of the offending boys.

W. C. T. U. Mrs. Kate Waller Barrett, of this city, will lecture in the Southern Methodist Episcopal Church on next Thursday evening, March 14th. Mrs. Barrett being such a highly cultured woman, and an eloquent speaker, all who attend can be assured a pleasant and profitable evening.

The Woman's Christian Temperance Union not only propose to furnish rest rooms for the pleasure and convenience of the visiting public at the Jamestown Exposition, but those having the work in charge will engage in the work of prevention and rescue, therefore the rooms at the exposition are a safeguard to those who visit there during the exposition. No admission fee to the lecture will be charged. A collection will be taken up.

Requisition Issued. Governor Shannon yesterday issued requisition papers for William Johnson, alias George Midgets (colored), who is wanted in Alexandria for killing Charles T. Smith, on upper King street, on Saturday night, October 20, 1906. Johnson is now held in Harrisburg, Pa. The requisition papers were received this morning by Commonwealth's Attorney Brent, and Mayor Palfi later detailed Officers Ferguson and Roberts to proceed to Harrisburg and bring Johnson to Virginia. The officers left here at 10:50 this morning.

Police Court. (Justice H. B. Cason presiding.) The following cases were disposed of this morning: Benjamin Motley, colored, arrested by Officer Henderson charged with stealing a stove and resisting an officer, was sent to jail for 90 days.

Josephine Cole, colored, arrested by Officer Talbot for drunken and disorderly conduct, was fined \$2.50.

Cora Davis, colored, arrested by Officers Beach and Young charged with assaulting Bessie Brown, colored, was fined \$5.

Old Tickets. Mr. Samuel Park, a contractor on the electric road, gave to a representative of the Gazette today two of the old tickets used on the street cars in this city in 1873. At that time a horse car line ran from the foot of King to Peyton street and then south to the Stone bridge at Duke street. On one side of the tickets is printed "Alexandria Passenger R. R. Company" and on the other side "King and Peyton streets." The tickets were purchased by Mr. Park's father, the late Philip Park, and are now real curiosities.
