BURNS WINS FIGHT.

Tommy Burns, the American heavy-weight pugilist, who claims the championship of the United States, Canada, and Australia, knocked out Gunner Moir, the English champion, in the tenth round of their battle before the National Sporting Club of London last night. The fight was supposed to be for the heavy-weight championship of the world, the club offering a purse of \$4,500, while the men made a side bet of \$2,500 each.

Burns went into the ring in the presence of a big crowd, the favorite at 10 to 8. He wanted to bet \$5,000, but found no takers. After the fight had begun his manager placed a part of this sum at odds on the proposition that Moir would be knocked out inside of ten rounds.

The fight was scheduled for twenty rounds with five-ounce gloves under Queensberry rules, with Eugene Corri, the referee, sitting outside of the ropes. Moir tipped the scales at about 187 pounds, while Burns weighed 180. The Englishman was three inches taller than the American, both men strapping in perfect condition, and also equally sure of success. The interest in the fight, which was the most important held in London since the Jackson-Slavin affair, some years ago, was widespread throughout the country.

Hundreds of Americans saw the mill and treated Burns to an ovation. Moir also got a royal welcome from the crowd. Moir profoundly disappointed his supporters. His blows were weak, and when he did get home on his opponent, he made no impression. He fought stubbornly and courageously, but without success.

Burns, on the other hand, was always confident, and always there. He had Moir guessing all the time, and beat him just when he thought he would.

By the end of the eighth round Moir's face was smothered in blood. Burns practically made a chopping block of it.

The tenth round saw the Englishman knocked down by a terrific blow under the chin and he was counted out.

Burns' supporters gave him an ovation. His skill was admitted and admired on all sides.

STEAMER ON THE ROCKS.

During a blinding snowstorm yesterday the Canadian Pacific R. W. Co. steamship Mount Temple, bound from Antwerp to St. John, N. B., with 600 passengers, struck the Howe Iron-bound ledge, fifteen miles south of Lunenburg, N. S., and was a total loss.

The work of transferring the passengers from the steamer to tugboats was being pushed as rapidly as possible yesterday, and it was believed all would be landed safely.

The Mount Temple left Antwerp on November 20, and on the run across she experienced much rough weather. Early yesterday the big vessel encountered a snowstorm, which made it impossible to see a ship's length ahead. The steamer ran too far to the westward, and was fully thirty miles out of her course when she struck the ledge.

The crash of the vessel on the rocks and the pounding of the surf caused consternation among the immigrants, especially the women, many of whom, with babies in their arms, ran wildly about the steamer, hysterically calling upon the officers and male passengers to save them. The sea was comparatively smooth at the time, and when the weather cleared the excitement subsided.

Signals of distress were displayed and guns were fired for assistance, but several hours elapsed before the wreck was discovered.

It is not definitely known how bad the Mount Temple is, but her position is dangerous. She is regarded as unfavorable for it is thought that many of her plates have been pierced by the jagged ledge. Should a storm develop she would undoubtedly be smashed to pieces within a short time.

The Mount Temple is a British vessel, built of steel, 6,661 net tons. Her length is 485 feet, and her breadth 59 feet. The vessel was built at Newcastle, England, six years ago.

MUTINEERS SENTENCED.

The court-martial which has been trying the men who participated in the recent mutinies at Vladivostok handed down its findings yesterday. Twenty-one men were sentenced to death, thirty-four were sent to the galleys, 140 were imprisoned for various terms, and five were acquitted.

According to a dispatch from Victoria, B. C., a runaway Russian destroyer, with a mutinous crew, is on a piratical cruise in the S. of Japan, according to reports brought from Nagasaki by the steamer Montevideo.

A German steamer reported at Nagasaki having been intercepted fifty miles north of Yushima Island by the destroyer, whose search on boarded the German steamer and forcibly took a large quantity of coal. The destroyer is reported as having escaped from Vladivostok.

The British steamer Port Maria, which arrived at Nagasaki with fugitives from Vladivostok, reported that severe fighting was in progress when she left, and that 280 men had been killed or wounded.

Discoveries of large quantities of arms and explosives were made and plans of the fortresses and rolls of revolutionaries unearthed by secret service officers in a Vladivostok shipyard, the finding of the mutineers of rebels being followed by hundreds of arrests, quickly succeeded by executions. A girl of seventeen was among those shot.
