BISHOP POTTER'S FUNERAL.

Bishops of the Episcopal Church from all parts of the country, 400 clergymen of the New York diocese and many from other dioceses will attend the public funeral services of Bishop Henry O. Potter in Grace Church, New York, on Tuesday morning, October 20.

This date will be the twenty-fifth anniversary of Bishop Potter's consecration as bishop. The postponement of the public service until then was due to the absence at the time of the bishop's death of many bishops and clergymen, who were attending a conference in London.

The Rt. Rev. David H. Greer, bishop of New York, will conduct the service. Afterwards there will be a funeral procession to the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, on Moraine Heights, where the body of Bishop Potter will be placed in the crypt in front of the altar of Tiffany Chapel. In accordance with the views of Bishop Potter, no flowers will be used either in Grace Church or at the cathedral, except on the altar.

CONSECRATED BISHOP.

It is explained that seldom is a Jesuit made a bishop in the Catholic Church, the members of the society being almost exclusively teachers and pastors. But precedent was broken yesterday when the Rt. Rev. Laurentius Veres of the Province of Mexico was consecrated bishop at Trinity Church Georgetown, D. C. The ceremony was very solemn and was conducted directly under the orders of the pope at Rome and dignified by the presence of the papal delegate, Donmede Falconio, the nearest representative of the pontiff in America.

BIG APPROPRIATION ASKED.

At the coming session of congress the District commissioners will ask for an appropriation of \$15,658,045.52, with which to maintain the government of the District during the fiscal year commencing July 1 next. This is \$2,000,000 more than they asked for the present year. Of this estimate of the administration's needs \$11,101,695.52 is to be applied to current expenditures and the sinking fund. The sum of \$4,556,350 is for what is termed extraordinary expenses, such as public improvements and projects.

PRESBYTERIAN SYNOD.

The second day of the one hundred and twenty-first annual session of the Presbyterian Synod of Virginia, which embraces all the Southern Presbyterian churches of this state, Maryland, West Virginia and the District of Columbia, now in session in Roanoke, was taken up with the presentation of reports, receiving of overtures, etc. The reports and overtures all went to their appropriate committees.

Among those who addressed the Synod yesterday was Capt. A. C. Tripp, of Baltimore, a member of the board of trustees of the Synod's Orphan's Home, at Lynchburg, who spoke in behalf of that institution.

Rev. J. W. Roobore, one of the trustees of the Union Theological Seminary, Richmond, tendered his resignation. He has removed from the jurisdiction of the Synod.

Montgomery Presbytery presented an overture asking a ruling on Sunday travel by ministers, laymen and baseball and football teams.

Last year there were nearly 2,000 farms bought in Virginia, by people from outside the state, the investments amounting to \$10,000,000. The population of Virginia is increasing every month. The farmers throughout the state are doing better work and raising finer stock than ever before.
