OLD DIPPLE GRAVEYARD.
To the Editor of the Alexandria Gazette:
The undersigned has been requested to write a letter to your widely circulated and valuable paper and to call the attention of the descendants of Dr. Gustavus Brown to the neglected condition of the old Dipple graveyard, where their ancestors have reposed for two hundred years. We request aid and co-operation in properly marking and caring for this sacred spot. Dr. Gustavus Brown lies in an unmarked grave at Rich Hill, Charles county, Md., and his wife, Frances Fowke, lies buried at Dipple, Stafford county, Va.; here also rest the M. Annes, Scotts and Horners, especially Horner, of Rippon, England, whose tombstones and monuments of solid stone and handsome designs are fast falling to decay and will all be destroyed in their present unprotected condition. Dipple graveyard is in full view of the majestic, beautiful Potomac; and is interesting to the visitor not only on account of the great natural beauties of the location but for historic association connected therewith.

From those who lie at Dipple have sprung a distinguished line of women and men noted for intellectual attainments, eminence in their profession and who have filled positions of importance and trust in national and state affairs. The women, distinguished for brilliant intellect, beauty, grace and charm, too much cannot be said of them. Among such a numerous family I am sure it will be considered a precious privilege to unite in making up a sum sufficient to put this spot so sacred to us in good condition. All are requested most earnestly to assist in this undertaking as they are able to do. Small sums will be gratefully received as well as large amounts. Contributions may be sent to Mrs. Col. Thos. STEAMBOAT INSPECTION.
In the new edition of the laws governing the steamboat inspection service of the United States, just issued, a number of changes have been made which are of interest to vessel owners and masters on the Potomac.

One is the new regulation governing the issuance of certificates to those who wish to operate gasoline engines or motors of any kind, except steam. Heretofore any person could obtain a license to operate a motor boat carrying freight and passengers by passing a required examination. No term of service on a motor driven vessel was required.

Under the new regulation no person shall receive an original license as engineer of vessels of above fifteen gross tons propelled by gas, fluid, naphtha or electric motors, carrying freight or passengers for hire, who has not served at least one year on motor boats, or in the engineers' department of steam vessels, or has not had at least two years' experience in the construction of marine motor engines and their installation.

Any person holding a license as engineer of steam vessels desiring to act as engineer of motor vessels must appear before a board of local inspectors for examination as to his knowledge of the machinery of such motor vessel, and if found qualified shall be licensed as engineer of motor vessels.

Sailing vessel owners who were contemplating putting gasoline power engines in their boats, intending to operate them themselves, under this regulation must employ an engineer, unless they have had the experience required, which few if any have. This, it is claimed, will work a hardship on small vessel owners employed in running freight on the Potomac and other interior waters of the country.

NEW IRISH LAND BILL IN.
Another land bill to facilitate the carrying out of the previous Irish Land Purchase act was introduced in the House of Commons last night by Chief Secretary for Ireland Birrell.

The chief secretary dealt in huge figures. He said he found that the estimate of \$500,000,000, made by one of his predecessors, (George Wyndham, as the amount necessary to satisfy the land hunger of the tenants, was totally inadequate; \$800,000,000 would be required for the purpose.

The completed transfers of land up to October 31 represented \$125,000,000, which had practically exhausted the amount realized from the issues of land stock. Pending transactions represented \$200,000,000, and the government intended to raise the money necessary to complete these transactions, leaving about \$500,000,000 to be dealt with later.

The secretary then said he proposed an issue of new 3 per cent stock to carry out the pending deal.
