Forty-seventh Anniversary.

Tuesday night last was the 47th anniversary of the capture in this town of Gen. Stoughton by Colonel Mosby. Mosby had only 29 men. His chief object was the capture of Sir Percy Wyndham, an English adventurer, who commanded a regiment of cavalry, and who had been proclaiming what he was going to do to Mosby. It so happened that Wyndham had gone to Washington the evening before, but Mosby picked up Gen. Stoughton, whose headquarters were in what is now the Episcopal rectory, and nearly 100 officers and men, and as many horses, &c. All this was accomplished without the firing of a shot, although there were several thousand federal troops encamped in and around Fairfax. The achievement was a daring one, and naturally made the Confederates leader famous. Gen. Stoughton died some years ago. Col. Mosby holds an important position in the Department of Justice in Washington, and retains, in marked degree, the mental and physical vigor which so characterized him in the strenuous days of 1861-'65.
