

NUNCIO NOT BLAMED.

The Vatican denies the recall of Mgr. Pignatello, the papal nuncio at Vienna. A high official, when questioned, said that the nuncio had not even been blamed, and that he had done nothing blameworthy in making a call of courtesy upon the American ambassador at a time when he could not avoid meeting Mr. Roosevelt. The nuncio's position, however, is critical, because the attitude he took in 1908 in the affair of Prof. Wahrmund, which offended the Austrian government and virtually ended the personal relations between the nuncio and Baron von Aehrenthal, the Austrian prime minister. The official intimated that notwithstanding this, the nuncio would remain in Vienna until the next consistory, when he will be made a cardinal.
