DUEL WITH RAZORS. Two men slashed each other to death with razors in Chicago last night following a quarrel over two young girls. A third man, who was badly cut about the head, escaped from the scene of the fight, and could not be found. The dead men were identified by hunting licenses found in their pockets as Paul Monino and Thomas Gagliano, both of Syracuse, Ill. The bodies were found in an alley last night. Near them were the razors with which they had fought. Both men had their throats cut and both were slashed in a score of other places. The girls about whom the men are supposed to have fought ran into a nearby saloon a few moments before the bodies were found. They asked where a policeman could be found, but ran away without waiting for a reply. The police were notified that a man had been cut about the head, had boarded a street car a block from where the bodies were found.

RELINQUISHES AUTHORITY. In a letter made public in Philadelphia Saturday, the Right Rev. Ozi W. Whitaker, the aged bishop of the Episcopal diocese of Pennsylvania, places the ecclesiastical authority of the diocese in the hands of Bishop Coadjutor Mackay-Smith. Bishop Whitaker, however, reserves for himself authority in five things which he specifies. They are: In making appointments for visitations to administer the rite of confirmation. In all matters arising under canon 1 to 8 inclusive of the general canons, the same relating to postulants and candidates for holy orders. In all matters arising under canon 38 of the general canons, the same being entitled "of the solemnization of matrimony."

In receiving notification of the name of any clergyman whom it is proposed to elect pastor of any parish as provided for in section 2, canon 14, of the general canons. In making appointments of ministers to be in charge of organized parishes in the diocese where such parishes receive aid from convocations in accordance with the provisions of section 8 of canon 8 of the canons of the diocese of Pennsylvania. Bishop Whitaker is 80 years old, and one of the best-known prelates in the Episcopal Church. He is in ill health, and this led him to give up the greater part of his authority.

Gen. James Oakes, who was retired in 1870 after 30 years of active service in the Mexican and civil wars, as well as the Indian uprisings in the southwest, sank unconscious to the pavement yesterday near his home in Washington and died 20 minutes later at a local hospital. Death was caused by heart disease. General Oakes was 80 years old. He was born near Limestone, Pa., April 4, 1826.
