Dr. Boyce D. Brooker, the fugitive Richmond physician, under indictment for selling prescriptions for habit-forming drugs to dope fiends, has it is said been definitely traced to London.

Capt. William I. Rasin, one of the best known Confederate veterans of Maryland and for a number of years deputy internal revenue collector at the Baltimore office died at Newport News Sunday.

Rev. J. O. Kirk, a Baptist minister, pastor during his life of various churches in Virginia, died yesterday morning at the home of his son, Mr. W. Fleet Kirk, near Lakeside, Richmond. He was the son of Dr. William H. Kirk, of Lancaster county.

With only three hours' preparation, Winchester held a monster preparedness parade last night. It was headed by the city band and Company I, Second Virginia Regiment, Capt. Robert V. Conrad commanding, which leaves Friday for mobilization camp at Richmond.

The board of visitors of the Virginia Military Institute, in session at Lexington yesterday authorized the superintendent, General E. W. Nichols, to tender to the Governor of Virginia the services of the cadets for drilling recruits in the State militia. A telegram to that effect was sent to Governor Stuart by General Nichols.

President Wilson sent to the Senate yesterday the nomination of Robert F. Whitehead, of Virginia, to be a Sistant Commissioner of Patents. Mr. Whitehead served as second assistant for years and his promotion is due to meritorious service. He is the son of Robert Whitehead, former Commonwealth's Attorney of Nelson county, and the nephew of the late Congressman Whitehead, of the Tenth Virginia district.

While Charles Zetty was fishing Monday in the Shenandoah river his hook caught in a woman's clothing. When the body was brought to the surface it proved to be that of Mrs. Bessie Lloyd, wife of Thomas Lloyd, a Norfolk and Western Railway man of Shenandoah City. Mrs. Lloyd was last seen Sunday night. Despondent from domestic troubles, she had been threatening to drown herself, and late Sunday night she stole away to the river and jumped in. She was born in Scotland 50 years ago.

Firms or partnerships, according to Executive Assistant Garnet, of the State Tax Board, are not required by the new income tax law, passed at the last session of the General Assembly, to make a return of their income nor to pay a tax thereon. The express language of the income tax law makes it apply to "each person or corporation." Mr. Garnett holds, therefore, that firms and partnerships as such are exempt, but that each person composing a firm or partnership is required to make a return of his personal income and be taxed thereon.

The Rev. Dr. Wayland F. Dunaway, one of the oldest Baptist ministers of Virginia, was taken ill yesterday afternoon at Kilmarnock while conducting the funeral services of Mrs. Allen in Kilmarnock Baptist Church, and retired to the hotel, where he died in a few hours. Dr. Dunaway was a native of Lancaster county. When the Civil War broke out he entered the Confederate Army and rose to the rank of captain serving for some time on the staff of Gen. A. P. Hill. After the war he was Commonwealth's Attorney of Northumberland county until he was removed by the reconstructing military authorities.

zens, held in the birthplace of President Wilson, in Staunton last night, the people of Staunton pledged themselves to support the wives and families of all members of Companies I and K, First Virginia Regiment, all of whom live in the city and county, while the men of these families are at the front. Staunton physicians also pledged themselves to give their services free to these families while the men are away. Money will be regarded as a loan, to avoid the appearance of charity, and may be repaid, if desired, by the men on their return.

James Henley, 23 years old, was convicted in the Hustings Court of Petersburg, yesterday of the murder of James Lewis, whom he stabbed to death on the night of April 9 at the Battersea cotton factory, where Lewis was employed as watchman. The jury returned a verdict of murder in the first degree and

fixed Henley's punishment as death. The court sentenced the convicted man to be electrocuted on September 29. The widow of the murdered man and Henley's mother were in the courtroom when the court passed the sentence of death, Counsel for Henley indicated their purpose to take the case to the Supreme Court of Appeals.
