**PEACE MOVE LAUNCHED**  
 General Conference of Episcopal Church Also Approves Rubric Urged by Rev. Dr. McKim.  
 St. Louis, Oct. 18.—The Episcopal general convention made the beginning yesterday of a world-wide move toward bringing about peace in Europe.  
 Both houses concurred in a resolution offered by the Rev. Lewis Stoeckton, of Buffalo, to appoint a commission to consider propounding suggestions for a constructive peace.  
 The resolution, originating in the upper house, contemplates a board of ten bishops, ten priests, and ten laymen to consider the promotion of international peace and the substitution of arbitration for warfare. The resolution was concurred in by the lower house.  
 In the house of bishops yesterday a long discussion developed over the proposal to curtail the commandments. The indications are that the upper house will reject the proposal. The lower house continued its consideration of the office of morning prayer. The most important change was that which permits the officers to end with the "Te Deum" when the Holy Communion is to follow.  
 There was also approved a rubric advocated by Rev. Dr. Randolph McKim, of Washington, making it possible to use any of the canticles printed with morning prayer in place of the "Te Deum."
