SHOULD HUNS FAIL TO SIGN

Allies Ready to Attack by Land, Sea And in Air
 London, June 21.—The Allies, and particularly Great Britain, are fully prepared to resume hostilities against Germany Tuesday morning if the Germans say no to the demand that they sign the Peace treaty.
 In marked contrast to war's accustomed secrecy there is little that is not known regarding what the Allies intend doing.
 Nevertheless the resumption of preparations for war is handled in a sensational way by the newspapers here.
 The Allies are ready to march on Berlin and occupy the German capital in a week. Meanwhile they say Allied navy and air forces will immediately put a blockade of Germany into effect and bring up high explosives for the use of the troops if the enemy resists the Allied march into Germany. It was stated

that these three arms of the service—the army, the navy and the air forces—are prepared as follows:
 Forty-seven army divisions, numbering half a million men and composed of twenty-five French divisions, ten British, six American and six Belgian, for the land forces, twelve British light cruisers and several destroyers are concentrated off Copenhagen, while the grand fleet is at the Firth of Forth and again on a war footing ready to put to sea in full battle array. All British air forces are mobilized at the Royal Air Force airfields with full complements of officers and men and two dirigibles, the R-33 and the R-34, are over Heligoland and Kiel respectively.
 It was stated yesterday that these dirigibles carried great stores of bombs and sealed orders, which when opened a thousand feet in the air sent them sailing eastward.
 Some observers in London believe the Germans may not sign, but a majority of them regard the dirigibles' expedition as good practice flights.


