**BEATS FARMER WITH PIPE**

Wicomico County, Md., Man Accused of Crushing Neighbor's Skull  
 Salisbury, Md., July 26.—In an altercation yesterday between two farmers and land owners in the eastern section of Wicomico county, Curtis Gordy is charged, attacked William Laws with a piece of iron pipe. Laws is in the Peninsula General Hospital, with a crushed skull, and Gordy is in the county jail awaiting the result of his injury.

Both of these farmers live near Wango, this county. It appears that Laws was hauling a load of corn to market, over an old road through the Gordy farm. The road, although not a public one, has been used by the public for 50 years or more. Some years ago the two men quarreled over some farm machinery, and have since ignored each other. Yesterday Laws was stopped by Gordy, who denied him the use of the road and ordered him to turn back.

Laws, without any show of temper according to witnesses, stated it was impossible to turn around on account of wet conditions, and said he was going to proceed on his way. Gordy is then said to have seized a piece of iron pipe and charged Laws, felling him to the ground and beating him till neighbors arrived.

An automobile was obtained and Laws was rushed to the hospital where a operation was performed, he is now hovering between life and death.  
 Gordy is denied bail, pending the outcome of Laws' injuries. Laws is single, Gordy has a wife and four children.

**GETS DEATH PENALTY**

Negro Bandit Accused of Killing Wife of Richmond Grocer

Richmond, Va., July 26.—Clifton Allen, a negro, 24 years old, was yesterday convicted of first degree murder and given the death penalty when tried in the Hustings Court on the charge of fatally shooting Mrs. Rosa Bicoff, while trying to rob her husband, Sam Bicoff, in his grocery at 1001 West Monroe street, on May 24 last. It was alleged that Allen entered the place masked and shot Mrs. Bicoff when she rushed to the assistance of her husband, just as he was commanded to give up the contents of the cash drawer.

Sam Hill, another negro, charged jointly with Allen, turned State's evidence and was used as a Commonwealth's witness. The two negroes were arrested in the city jail several weeks after the hold-up while being imprisoned for another robbery.

**ITALIAN AND SLAVS CLASH**

Twelve Killed in Battle at Volosca, Near Fiume

Laibach, Austria, July 26.—Eight Italian carabinieri and four Jugoslavians were killed in a clash at Volosca, near Fiume, yesterday, according to a dispatch from Agram.

The encounter was said to have occurred after the Italians tried to break up a meeting called to consider sending Slav children to Croatia so that they would not have to attend Italian schools.
