

**SHOOT'S CRAZED NEGRO**  
 Maryland Physician Attacked and Throttled in His Home  
 Cumberland, Md., Feb. 13.—The condition of Theodore Williams, 40 years old, the colored hod carrier who was shot by Dr. Herbert V. Deming, physician, North Center street, after the negro had invaded the Deming home early Wednesday morning, was reported critical at the Allegany Hospital yesterday. It is through the exertions of the negro after being wounded have lessened his chances of recovery.

With two punctures in the stomach and two in the abdomen, Williams rushed from the Deming home, to return later. When chased away the second time he sought the home of Frederick Hering, on another street, and broke the front door by force. He was smashing dishes and furniture when arrested by Assistant Chief of Police J. Peter Minnick and Patrolman John J. Trieber.

On January 7 the negro was committed to jail for observation on a lunacy charge. Dr. Deming was one of the examining physicians. Later the negro was released at the request of his sister, who said she would care for him.

**"NO BEER, NO WORK" IS CRY**  
 Shortage in Ranks of Snow Diggers Explained by Signs Stuck in Drifts

New York, Feb. 13.—The difficulty the city has had in obtaining men to clear the streets of snow was given a new explanation Wednesday when numerous signs were stuck in the snow banks throughout the city carrying such inscriptions as: "No Beer, No Work" and "Let the Prohibitionists Shovel the Snow."

For the first time in nearly a week surface cars appeared Wednesday in lower Broadway and other parts of the city, but they carried no passengers.

They were work cars sent out to dig ice off the tracks and were followed by hundreds of uniformed motormen and conductors armed with picks, shovels and scrapers. When service will be resumed remains problematical.
