The man was Warren Cranmer, 42 years old, of near Colestown. His 19-year-old son John was operating the machine, but he escaped injury.

#### DONATES \$18,500 GEMS

**Mrs. Nathan Straus Gives All Her Precious Stones to Aid Palestine**  
New York, June 25.—Mrs. Nathan Straus has donated all her jewels, valued at \$18,500 to the Zionist organization of America, for the development of medical and health service in Palestine, the organization announced here recently. She made the gift at the same time her husband gave the Zionist organization \$100,000 for a health and medical research department for the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, but at her request it was not made public until after she had sailed for Europe. Mr. and Mrs. Straus are now on their way to Palestine. Mrs. Straus' action in giving up jewels, many of which were heirlooms has started a similar movement

among the Jewish women of England and Palestine, according to reports received at Zionist headquarters here.

#### SHOW MEMBERS START RIOT

**Trouble Begins When Locomotive Crashes Into Company's Train**  
Milton, Pa., June 25.—Employees of a traveling carnival show started a riot here Saturday when a locomotive sent to pull their train to another town crashed into it, damaging their property and injuring some of the members, two seriously. The injured are James Montcomery, New York, broken shoulder and internal injuries; Harry Jones, 19, Philadelphia, arm and shoulder broken.






