Annapolis, Md., Oct. 16.—Baltimore Sunday afternoon movies received a knock-out blow here yesterday from the Court of Appeals. A proposition to let Baltimoreans vote on having cinema pictures after 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon, was returned marked "Disapproved."
The action of the appeals court reverses the ruling of Judge Morris in the Supreme Court, Baltimore, and is a signal victory for the Lord's Day Alliance, heading the fight against the Sunday movies plan. The movie fans wanted to vote for the open cinema along with the larger political questions on election day, November 2.

POLAND CALLED FOR TRIAL BY WORLD LEAGUE

Paris, Oct. 16.—Poland has been summoned to the bar of the league of nations. It is the first time a nation has been called before such an international body to answer to a jury of its peers.

Leon Bourgeois, president of the council of the league of nations, has called Ignace Paderewski, Poland's representative, to answer to the occupation of Vilna. Bourgeois declared that the council, including the Ambassadors at Paris of Japan and Spain, charged with him to follow the movement of Polish affairs, were surprised at the occupation of Vilna following the armistice, and that if the city were not at once evacuated the League would take action.

PONZI DECLARED INSOLVENT

Bankruptcy Referee Says "Wizard's" Claims Are Guilty of Usury.
Boston, Oct. 16.—Charles Ponzi, whose international postal coupon scheme and offers of 50 per cent profits in 45 days collapsed two months ago, with millions of public investments tied up in it, was declared insolvent yesterday by James D.

Olmstead, referee in bankruptcy. In a report submitted to the Federal district court, the referee found that Ponzi had no partners.

Kremlin Invaded By Moscow Rebels, Is Report to Germany.

Zurich, Oct. 16.—According to an announcement of the German foreign ministry, a great revolt is reported to have started in Moscow. The Kremlin there is declared to have been invaded.

Mexico City, Oct. 16.—The volcano of Popocatepetl was in eruption yesterday for the first time in more than 400 years. A dense cloud of black smoke is belching forth. With the first sign of activity of the ancient crater a panic started in the nearby towns, but this was allayed when observation failed to disclose any lava.
