


Madrid's Bread Lines Lengthen resulting from the strike of the bakers and the bread lines everywhere were
 Madrid, Nov. 29.—The situation here showed no improvement today, even longer than those of Saturday.

Soldiers Arrive at Mine Town; Place Looks Like Armed Camp
 Williamson, W. Va., Nov. 29.—A provisional battalion of approximately 500 men of the United States Army camp at Chillicothe, Ohio, arrived here today at noon. Col. Her-

man Hall, commanding, immediately took up his headquarters at the county Courthouse and armed guards were thrown out around the building.
 The troops are here in response to a request of Gov. John J. Corn-

well to put an end to disorders of the past few weeks. Since their arrival the town has taken on the appearance of a military camp. The streets are filled with army mules, trucks and other paraphernalia. Officers will be billeted in the Courthouse and the

enlisted men are being quartered in the City Hall and an old hotel. Detachments of soldiers have already been sent to Kermit, Borderland and Matewan for guard duty. No disorders have been reported since the arrival of the troops.
