SUN AND DROUGHT PROVE TO BE MOST POTENT PROHIBITION TEAM

Lexington, Ky., July 12.—Thirty or sixty days from now, if the sun shines there won't be any moonshine still.

Continued hot weather and lack of rain has caused an involuntary slump in the activities of moonshiners in the Eastern Kentucky mountains that may result in a return to war-time prices for corn liquor, according to Deputy United States Marshal Dave Reagan of Frankfort, and H. C. Caudie, of Hazard, who were in Lexington to confer with State Prohibition Director Samuel Collins.

In the winter and spring months, these officers say, "wet weather" branches are to be found in every ravine that will furnish sufficient water to operate a still, but since the present drought has been in effect only the larger streams furnish sufficient water for moonshining purposes and many of the stills are taking an enforced vacation along with the prohibition agents.
