ARTICLE 1.—NAME. This association shall be called the Goodhue County Patrons of Husbandry Mutual Benefit Association.

ARTICLE 2.—OBJECT. The object of this association is to provide a fund for the ready and immediate relief...

ARTICLE 3.—MEMBERSHIP. The membership of this association shall consist of 4th degree Patrons of Husbandry...

ARTICLE 4.—OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES.

§ 1. The officers of this association shall consist of a President, one Vice President...

§ 2. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all the meetings...

§ 3. In the absence of the President the senior Vice President shall perform all duties...

§ 4. The Secretary shall keep a true record of all the proceedings of the association...

§ 5. The Treasurer shall receive and hold all monies and other property of the association...

ARTICLE 5.—EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The President, Sen. Vice President, by election, and Secretary shall constitute an Executive Committee...

ARTICLE 6.—MEETINGS AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

§ 1. The meetings of this association shall be held on the 3d Wednesday of December in each year...

§ 2. Fifteen members of the association shall constitute a quorum to transact business.

PAYMENT OF INSURANCE.

§ 1. On the death of a member of this association the Grange to which such person belonged shall certify under seal of the Grange the facts of the decease...

ARTICLE 7. DUES.

§ 1. Any person entitled to membership in this association shall, on signing this constitution, pay to the Secretary the sum of two dollars and ten cents...

§ 2. It shall be the duty of each and every member of this association, on being notified of the decease of any member...

§ 3. It shall be the duty of the Secretary upon the death of a member, to notify each member of the association.

§ 4. Any member failing to pay the required amount for more than thirty days after being so notified...

§ 5. Any member who may change his place of residence shall be required to notify the Secretary...

ARTICLE 8.—SPECIAL MEETINGS.

§ 1. Special meetings of the association may be held by adjournment at annual meetings, or in ten days' notice by the Secretary...

ARTICLE 9.—AMENDMENTS.

§ 1. This constitution may be altered or amended at any meetings. After a thorough discussion of the subject, a motion was carried that the chair appoint a committee...
