PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS.

To be voted upon at the next General Election, (Published in Pursuance of Chapter 157, General Laws of 1887.)

WHEREAS, It is made the duty by law of the Attorney General to prepare a synopsis of all amendments proposed to the constitution...

And each voter shall vote upon by placing a cross (X) opposite "yes," if he desires to vote in the affirmative, and opposite the word "no," if he desires to vote in the negative.

And there may be levied and collected an annual tax upon the owners, lessees, tenants, or occupants of any real estate...
