John Saxon, Indian Lake.

In honor of the splendid fight made in the western part of Jackson county for the removal of the county seat Lakefield gave a banquet. About 600 were present. The handsome new building was dedicated as a town hall. Lakefield only lacked a few votes of having enough to move the county seat—the changing of 20 votes would have done it. Lakefield had 1503 votes while Jackson had only 1300, but the law requires 55 per cent to move the county seat. As the western part of the country is settling up much faster than the eastern part it can be safely said that Lakefield is the future county seat, and Jackson cannot hope to hold it but five years longer.
