CURRENT TOPICS.

THE NEWS IN BRIEF.

The Prohibitionists of New Hampshire have nominated Josiah W. Fletcher for Governor.

A bill before the Legislature of Vermont imposes a fine of \$10 for offering a boy under 15 years of age a cigar or a cigarette.

A bill providing that criminals shall be made inebriate before execution has been introduced in the Vermont Legislature.

Twenty Mormon Elders have left Salt Lake for missionary work in the Southern States, and seventy-five for the European field.

Secretary Frelinghuysen has officially expressed to Henry George the respect of the British Government for his recent article in *Reform*.

A quarantine against all Southern points has been established at Bagdad, at the mouth of the Rio Grande, ostensibly to prevent the spread of cholera from the Mexican States.

Asbury University, at Greenocastle, Ind., is to receive an endowment of \$10,000 from Hon. W. C. DePaul, on condition that it assume the name and comply with some pecuniary requirements.

Pleuro-pneumonia has appeared among the cattle near Lancaster, Penn. J. H. Sanders, President of the National Cattle Commission, pronounces Baltimore and the farms adjacent a hotbed of the disease.

Several resolutions in the shape of new indictments are promised in the star route cases. Brady, Dorsey & Co., are said to be thoroughly scared, and it is alleged the Administration will furnish them neither aid nor comfort.

Advices from Panama say matters on the south coast have a more pacific tendency than for a long time past, and the pressure brought to bear through the movements of people of Peru and Bolivia is having a marked effect.

In an interview at Kansas City, Mo., the other day, ex-Secretary Depue sharply criticized the Government officials connected with the star route cases, and reiterated the statement that he had never defrauded the country of one cent.

The preliminary election for members of the Prussian Diet resulted, as far as estimated, in the choice of 2,900 electors belonging to the Progressist and Seccessionist groups, against 750 Conservatives and anti-Progressionists.

The bankers of Chicago are earnest and united in their disapproval of the ruling of Secretary Folger that gold certificates can only be procured at the sub-Treasury in New York, which forces upon Western people express charges in both directions, on the coin and the paper.

The Secretary of War has submitted to the Judge-Advocate General for his opinion the question whether persistent refusal on the part of an officer of the army to pay just debts does not make him liable to trial by court-martial upon charges unbecoming an officer and a gentleman.

The President has suspended Jonathan Diggs, Indian Agent at Colorado River Agency, and appointed John W. Clark his successor. McMillen, of the Mesquero Agency, tendered his resignation, but the Secretary of the Interior declined to accept it, pending the result of the investigation now in progress.

Ignacio L. Villasta, Chief Justice of the Mexican Supreme Court, was proclaimed Vice-President under the recent constitutional amendment. He promptly resigned, on the ground that his political relations interfere with his judicial duties. He has been a Governor, Congressman, and Cabinet Minister.

Reports to the Canadian Government indicate an uprising of the Indians on Caradoc Reserve, in the Northwest Territories, who have formally decided not to leave to the whites any portion of their lands. General Crook, in a conference with four hundred chiefs and head men of the Apaches, at San Carlos, forbade them to leave the reservation without papers, and ordered them to stop manufacturing liquor.

A dispatch was recently sent from Chicago stating that three lives were lost on Lake Michigan through a ruling by the Supervising Inspector of Steam Vessels that tug boats must not take passengers on board, under a penalty of \$500. The Inspector says that no regulation ever made by the department could be tortured into a prohibition of saving life, the only restriction being as to equipments for the safety of passengers. Chicago tugmen are said to have boasted that they would suffer people to drown.

Mr. John A. Cockerill, editor of the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch*, has been released from custody on furnishing bonds to the amount of \$10,000 to answer a charge of murder in the second degree. In swearing out a warrant which was intended merely to hold the accused for a judicial investigation, and not to decide the justice or injustice of the case, the Prosecuting Attorney has only done the duty required of him by law. Judge Cady will hear the case on November 2, when the accused may be held for murder in the degree charged, the degree may be reduced to manslaughter, or the prisoner may be acquitted. This decision will be the first final determination of the real merits of the case.

The Irish national conference at Dublin opened with nearly eight hundred delegates in attendance. Parnell and Davitt were greeted by wild cheers. Almost all the extreme Irish members of Parliament were present. Parnell was called to the chair and Brennan and Sexton chosen secretaries. A letter from Treasurer Egan, at Paris, conveying his resignation, stated that funds of the Land League amounting to £244,820 had passed through his hands, the sum remaining being £23,000. A vote of confidence was passed. Numerous letters and telegrams from the United States were read. The scheme for the establishment of an Irish national league was adopted. Davitt declared that until the land stolen from the people was restored there could be no final settlement of the land question.

PERSONAL AND GENERAL.

S. J. THOMPSON, editor of the *Daily Republican*, Shelbyville, Ind., has been sentenced to thirty days in jail for contempt of court. The paper had severely criticized the Grand Jury for failing to find an indictment in a certain case, stating that the man was clearly guilty, but that influence had been used to secure his release. Mr. Thompson was summoned and asked to give his authority for the statement, but he refused to answer.

GEORGE HORNE, a brakeman, was killed while coupling cars at Lenox, Iowa, on the 17th. His head was crushed between the bumpers.

L. C. KEMFRO, a well-known citizen of San Saba County, Texas, charged with having killed Winfield Seay, near Carthage, Mo., seventeen years ago, has just been arrested.

FROST'S large flour mills at Minnesota City burned on the 18th. The loss is very heavy.

J. H. RUEL, general manager for Kaufman & Thurg, Galveston, Texas, took a dose of poison the other day. He had been speculating in "futures," and when called upon for a statement of the affairs of the firm, found himself unable to cover heavy losses. Disipation and domestic troubles are believed to have led to the tragedy.

WOOSTER, Ohio, had a case of strychnine. Daniel Brewster, a conductor on the Philadelphia, Wilmington & Baltimore road, killed himself at Philadelphia on the same day.

THOMAS SEDLACK, an inoffensive Bohemian, was killed by Wm. Swab, a saloon-keeper, in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the other night. The murder was wholly unprovoked.

THE Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons in session at Cleveland, Ohio, visited Garfield's grave the other day.

ANTON WECKEMEYER and the brothers Joshua and Samuel Shipley got into a fight while working on a scaffold at the third story of a house in Baltimore, Md., the other day. The scaffold gave way and all three fell to the pavement. Weckemeyer died soon after and the others are in a critical condition.

AT Hoboken, N. J., on the 17th, Policeman Kerrigan was probably fatally beaten with his own club by a boatman named Finch, whom he had arrested.

WILLIAM CARRINGTON, an attorney in New York, went with a diamond broker of his acquaintance to secure on approval \$3,000 worth of jewels at a Broadway house the other day, and there snatched the treasures from his friend. He pawned two-thirds of the stones, and returned to the store with the remainder. He was then taken to the Tombs.

THREE men made a desperate attempt to rob the bank at Hagerstown, Md., the other day, while all the employees but the teller had gone to dinner. One of the trio engaged the attention of a second doctored under the counter into the vault, but fled on being discovered.

HARRY JAMES, aged 22, employed on the steamer Coahoma, committed suicide at Memphis, Tenn., the other day, shooting himself in the head. Domestic trouble was the cause.

A PRAYER-MEETING in the Baptist Church at Roxborough, N. C., the other evening, was abruptly terminated by the fall of an immense chandelier. A number of worshippers were injured in the panic which ensued.

THOMAS MURPHY, a noted burglar in jail at Greencastle, Ind., made his escape here, the other day, by knocking down the sheriff and locking him in.

BENJAMIN LEGAULT, of Beauharnois, Quebec, has entered action to prevent his widowed sister, 65 years of age and worth a hundred thousand dollars, from marrying a young man.

A TRAIN on the Albany & Susquehanna Road, broke through a bridge above New York, the other day, and the locomotive and fifteen coal cars were precipitated into the river. Fireman Stapleton was killed, and Engineer Ryndes and Brake-man Burstedt seriously injured.

J. H. COREY, proprietor of the Bellevue Hotel, Long Branch, N. J., who would not allow two gentlemen to remain in his establishment for a few days unless paid \$2,500, has been indicted for robbery, riot, extortion, assault and battery, and maintaining a nuisance.

A TRAIN of twenty-five empty stock-cars made a test of the Northern Pacific iron bridge across the Missouri at Mandan, Dakota, the other day, amid salutes from the steamboats and locomotives in sight. On the return trip eight heavily-loaded cars were attached, and no vibration was felt.

PHILADELPHIA has been excited by a series of remarkable explosions of gas mains under Twentieth street. Things were badly shaken up, but nobody was hurt.

THE suit of Marie Prescott, the actress, against the President of the American News Company, New York, resulted in a verdict of \$12,500 for plaintiff.

SMALL-POX is raging at Paterson, N. J., in spite of wholesale vaccination. It is charged that the virus obtained is useless.

AT Eastman, Ga., Oct. 20, Joe King, Rob Donaldson, Simon O'Quinn, Reddick Powell, and Ella Moore, all colored, were hanged for participating in the riot at a camp-meeting in August last which ended in the murder of James Hazzard, a young white man.

A REMARKABLE tragedy was enacted in Knoxville, Tenn., on the 19th, three prominent citizens engaging in a deadly rencontre on a public thoroughfare. Thomas O'Connor, lessee of the State Reformatory, an extensive dealer in saddlery and harness, and President of the Mechanics' National Bank, shot and killed Joseph A. Mabry, Sr., and J. A. Mabry, Jr., receiving his own death wound at the hands of the latter. The difficulty, so far as can be learned, originated at the East Tennessee Fair

grounds on the previous afternoon, Mabry senior branding O'Connor as a swindler, scoundrel, etc., and telling him that he was the cause of the murder of his son, Will Mabry, who was killed by Constable Luby in December last. Mr. O'Connor declined an invitation to fight then and there, saying he would settle matters at another time. On the fatal morning O'Connor saw Gen. Mabry approaching the bank, and stepping inside for a shot-gun he discharged both barrels and killed his man.
