- 400 one-pound packages of Sudan grass.
- 365 five-pound packages of fetterita.
- 80 four-pound packages of milo.
- 45 four-pound packages of Kansas grown alfalfa.

On account of the limited supply, no individual will receive more than one package of seed of any one variety. Any one desiring a package should drop a card to Senator Thompson, Washington, D. C., right away.


