WICHITA MARKETS.

Hogs Opened Steadily at Saturday's Quotations, but Declined Slightly at the Close—Cattle Market a Little Off, in Sympathy with Eastern Markets—Large Supplies of Grain Coming in and an Active Demand for Choice Grades—Other Markets'

There was a good supply of stock, both in quality and quantity, at the yards yesterday. The hog market opened firm at Saturday's close, but later in the day advanced received from eastern markets reported cattle lower and a decline of one to one and a half cents.

Mr. J. H. Sparks, a heavy shipper from Conway Springs, came in with sixty hogs averaging 250 pounds, and sold them at good prices. He has for many years been a patron of the Kansas City market, but in consideration of distance and freight he says everything is now largely in favor of the Wichita market. A letter was also received by a well known commission firm yesterday from the Kiowa Cattle company asking for information and expressing a desire to patronize this market in the future.
