Valuable Agricultural Tables.

AVERAGE QUANTITY OF VEGETABLE SEED PER ACRE.

Table with columns for vegetable types (Dwarf beans, Marrowfat peas, etc.) and their average quantities per acre.

QUANTITY OF SEED REQUIRED FOR A GIVEN NUMBER OF HILLS.

Table showing quantities of seeds for various crops like Pole beans, Corn, Cucumbers, etc., based on the number of hills.

ONE OUNCE OF SEED WILL PRODUCE OF APPARATUS ABOUT 500 PLANTS.

Table listing various seeds and their corresponding quantities, such as Broccoli, Cabbage, Carrots, etc.

QUANTITY OF SEED SOWN TO AN ACRE.
