ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
— OF THE —  
BLACK QUARTZ MINES CO.

First: The name of the corporation is the Black Quartz Mines Company.  
Second: The principal place of business shall be at Prescott, Yavapai county, in the territory of Arizona; and a branch office in the city of Philadelphia, state of Pennsylvania, and branch offices in such other places as the board of directors may from time to time designate in the United States, and in such other places in the territory of Arizona as it may find convenient for the proper conduct of its business.
