LETTERS FROM THE PEOPLE.

PAID, TEXAS, May 22, 1881. MR. EDITOR: I know of no better way of giving you the real condition of the country than by furnishing statistical data, which are as follows: Population of this county, 27,000; number of mortgages placed on record from January 1st on personal property, from \$10 to \$250, 44, all from tenants to landlords; from landlords to merchants, none; number of mortgages on real estate to secure money loans, 11; number of true bills by grand jury in last court, 102; finances of this county as follows, courthouse and jail, cost of building, \$62,900; outstanding unmortgaged 8 per cent. bonds, about \$40,000; cash now in treasury to pay said bonds on maturity, \$11,608, bondholders refusing to yield their bonds till maturity; in hands of treasurer, as a general county fund, \$17,726; school fund on hand accumulated to date for this year, \$16,608; jury fund on hand, \$3,836. Thus you have the finances of this (Lamar) county. This town has two banks, one with a capital of \$250,000, the other \$300,000; the town handles 30,000 bales cotton; has now three schools, each with an average attendance of 150 to 200 scholars. A large college is now in course of erection, to be finished during the present year; there are also two furniture factories, three flouring mills, about half a dozen corn mills, one ice factory; gas works, three foundries; four planing mills; one gin factory; one marble yard, one oil-press; three weekly papers; one tannery; street cars; one machine shop; an opera-house capable of seating 1,000 persons; twelve brick buildings are now under contract, to be erected this summer. This town numbers 5,000, and is improving rapidly; the country surrounding this place is being settled

At night an immense crowd assembled, and the students, male and female, entertained the audience by essay, dialogue, declamation and orations until a late hour of the night. They acquitted themselves most handsomely. This passed a most pleasant evening. Prof. Orme is one of the most energetic and capable teachers in this section, as his success abundantly attests. He has a large school, and his services are in demand at many points. The McDonalds, Hudsons, Neelys, Stokes, Fosters and others are proud of their school, and rally as real friends around this school. This they should do. To do otherwise would prove true untrue to the education of their children. We are indebted to the citizens of that section for many kind attentions. When en route home we stopped at Middleton, and are pleased to know that the district in that place will soon be covered with a fine brick block of stores. The school there under Prof. Kimbrough is doing a vast deal of good. The attendance is increasing, and the advancement of the scholars is all that could be desired. Prof. Kimbrough is an experienced and learned teacher. The News is progressing, and we congratulate the junior editor, Coburn, that married life is making him give the public a much better paper. The chief editor, Wilson, is as solid and worklike as a man can be.

Southern Farmers.

The editor of the Danville (Va.) News talks like a sage when he assures us that if Southern farmers wish to become more prosperous they should at once abandon the pernicious credit system. In the cotton States, particularly, it is a weighty drawback. As the system is practiced the farmer gives the merchant a lien on his crops to be grown, and the merchant being fully secured, furnishes the necessary supplies and fixes his own prices. The farmer is thus wholly at the mercy of the merchant, and has no redress against exorbitant rates. A decision has just been rendered by the Supreme Court of Mississippi which will afford the farmers of the State some relief. A merchant who held a mortgage on the crops of a farmer foreclosed it. The lower court allowed his bill against the farmer, although it was shown that the prices charged were at least double what they should have been; but the higher court, in its decision, affirmed that the purchaser was not in a position to decline the purchase on account of the prices charged, and that he acquiesced in the price from an overruling necessity. His extortion against the prices fixed was without consideration, and was, therefore, void.
