Shoddy Carriages.

Shoddy carriages are, it is plain, much more dangerous to those who use them than shoddy pianos. If the Carriage Monthly is correct in its statements, the manufacture of the former is as common as of the latter.

The subject is of grave interest not only to carriage manufacturers and owners, but to the general public, for a wrecked vehicle is likely to endanger more lives than that of the party riding in it.

Rising with the Lark.

A correspondent of an English journal, who had been out in the woods early in the morning, taking notes of the habits of the birds, thinks the old saying, "rising with the lark," means more, at this season of the year, than many suppose.

See that the sink water is carried away from the vicinity of the well and not allowed to seep into the ground near the house. Neglect of this is the fruitful cause of typhoid fever and diphtheria.

Sulphur for Sows.—A correspondent of the Ohio Farmer writes: "Years ago I was told by a young Scotchman that if I would feed my sow plenty of sulphur for several days previous to farrowing time as well as occasionally afterwards, I would have no trouble."

To Keep Furs in Summer.—Furs or woollens may be kept safe from moths during the summer by brushing thoroughly, so as to eradicate all the moth eggs; then wrap them up in newspapers so that every part is covered entirely.

A very excellent soup for summer: Eight potatoes, boiled soft; pieces of butter size of two eggs; boil one quart of milk and one quart of water together, and pour boiling hot on the soft potatoes, strain, and then boil half an hour in the milk and water.

Bees Changing their Habits.

Some curious facts from the world of nature crop up occasionally, which are well worthy of consideration. For instance, it has been proved that the bee may, under certain circumstances, turn out to be any thing but the pattern of industry it is proverbially supposed to furnish.

Directions for Planting Grapes.

Any soil that is sufficiently rich for garden vegetables, is rich enough for grapes. Very wet or heavy clay lands, however, should not be selected, unless first well drained.

Whisky Drinking in New York.

The proprietor of the Metropolitan Hotel told me last night that his bar receipts were \$175 a day. If we suppose the average receipts at the bars to be \$20 a day, about \$220,000 would have been spent every day for liquor in New York by tipplers alone.

I have tried sun flower seeds this year with good results. At first my fowls would not eat them, not seeming to distinguish them from sticks or stones, but in a short time they learned to spit upon the shells and devour the kernels with a gusto, and the effect in glossing the plumage was very soon noticeable.
