Six years ago Smith, who was supposed to be dying of consumption, was pardoned, and to quickly regain his health and re-marry, while his faithful first love was removed to the house of correction, and lived on without hope. When shown her pardon, the other lady, she was too much overcome to speak. She will return to her father's home, where she feels sure of a reception, not only by him, but by her old neighbors.

The fact that a sewing machine had been purchased by some Indian was mentioned in the Omaha 'Bee' recently as a proof that civilization was advancing among the red men.
