A Full Answer Made to the Charges. MR. DONNELLY'S SPEECH ENTIRE.

From the Congressional Globe of May 2d.

Mr. Speaker, on the 20th of March last, I asked in this House unanimous consent to introduce a bill for a land grant to aid in the construction of a railroad from the town of Taylor's Falls, in the State of Minnesota, by way of St. Cloud to the western boundary of the State; and asked that it be referred to the Committee on Public Lands and printed.

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Thus it appears, Mr. Speaker, that the gentleman from Illinois came with about a million acres of the trust.

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
