An exchange tells the ladies how to prepare Tomato Sauce. These are the directions: Gather your tomatoes when fully ripe, and after washing, wash them in some suitable vessel. Then place them in a kettle over a moderate fire, and when just warmed through, press a cucumber down upon them—then dipping from the cucumber all the watery juice possible. After boiling it a short time, strain the mass through a sieve, just fine enough to retain the seeds of the fruit—then return it to the kettle, and boil it down to the desired consistency, (some prefer it thin, as it retains more of the flavor,) taking all care that it does not become scorched in the process. Heat the bottles you intend to use, in a steamer, to boil-heat, and while they retain this heat, fill them with sauce in a boiling state. Then cork immediately with good corks, and place them where they will cool slowly.

Arrival of the Steamer Fulton. Two days later from Europe—Terrible Railroad Collision in England—The Chinese Treaty, &c.

St. Johns, Sept. 4.—The steamship Fulton, from Havre via Southampton, at 3.10 P.M., of the 27th, was intercepted off Cape Race at 3.50 P.M., on Friday, but owing to unfavorable weather, our dispatches did not reach here till a late hour last evening.

The steamship Indian, from Quebec on the 4th, arrived at Liverpool on the 24th.

Queen Victoria continued her progress in Germany. She was received everywhere with the most extravagant demonstrations of respect.

Preparations were making for a royal visit to Leeds on the return of the Queen from Germany. The Agamemnon had been on fire, but fortunately sustained little damage. There had been a collision between two excursion trains on the Oxford and Wolverhampton Railway, involving dreadful consequences. Several persons were killed, and a great many fatally injured.

Accounts of the harvest in Great Britain are very satisfactory. The late rain caused some delay in the gathering, but no permanent injury was done. The treaty concluded with the Chinese does not confer on the Allies the right of having permanent diplomatic agents at Peking, but their Consul General, residing at Tien, will be admitted to direct intercourse with the Cabinet of the Emperor.

A telegram from St. Petersburg says the Chinese Empire is to be open to foreigners, and the left bank of the Amour River is henceforth to be the boundary between Russia and China. Baron Gras, the French Plenipotentiary, is expected home from China in October.

Messrs. Clondomar, Duncan and Kibbs, of Liverpool, has suspended, but their estates will cover their liabilities.

The Emperor Alexander, of Russia, will arrive at Warsaw on the 14th September, when the 35,000 troops, who have been concentrated there, will be reviewed by him. The Grand Duke Nicholas and Michael go to the Caucasus to take part in the military operations against Shamlah.

The French Ambassador at Constantinople sent a dispatch to the Porte supporting the application of Prince Danicils of Montenegro, who demands of the Turkish Government to give up to him the harbor of Spitzin, in the Adriatic, which he claims in Montenegrin territory.

The Fulton has 214 passengers, and no specie. She will be due at New York on Tuesday.

LATER.—The following intelligence is gleaned from papers obtained from the steamship Fulton, off Cape Race:—The steamship Vigo, from New York, August 12th, was signalled off Holyhead on the evening of the 21th.

A Bristol dispatch of the 24th says that the ship Magistrate, of New Orleans, was passed waterlogged abandoned, Aug. 6th, in latitude 42, longitude 48. The crew were saved and landed here.
