BOGUS MONEY DEALERS. More of Them Made Public. (From the Press & Herald, Oct. 22.)

One of the Modes of Financing. By Lawfully. Suppose some capitalists were to publish an advertisement in substance like this: "Money to lend and interest paid to the borrower..."

1. Paperism prevails in New England. The remaining portion of the forty-four to every 10,000 of the entire population.

2. In the native New England population the ratio is forty-seven to every 10,000. In the entire white population of the South, native and foreign, the ratio is only fourteen to 10,000.

3. In the foreign population of the New England States the ratio of paperism is thirty-five thousand to every 10,000. Among the colored people of the Southern States the ratio is thirteen to every 10,000.

In the United States census tables of criminal statistics we are told that in the entire New England population the proportion is 11 in 10,000; in the entire Southern population it is 8 in 10,000.

Another surprising revelation which the census tables disclose is in reference to church accommodations: 1. In the New England States there are 5,421 churches, with 2,263,607 sittings. Total population, 3,487,094.
