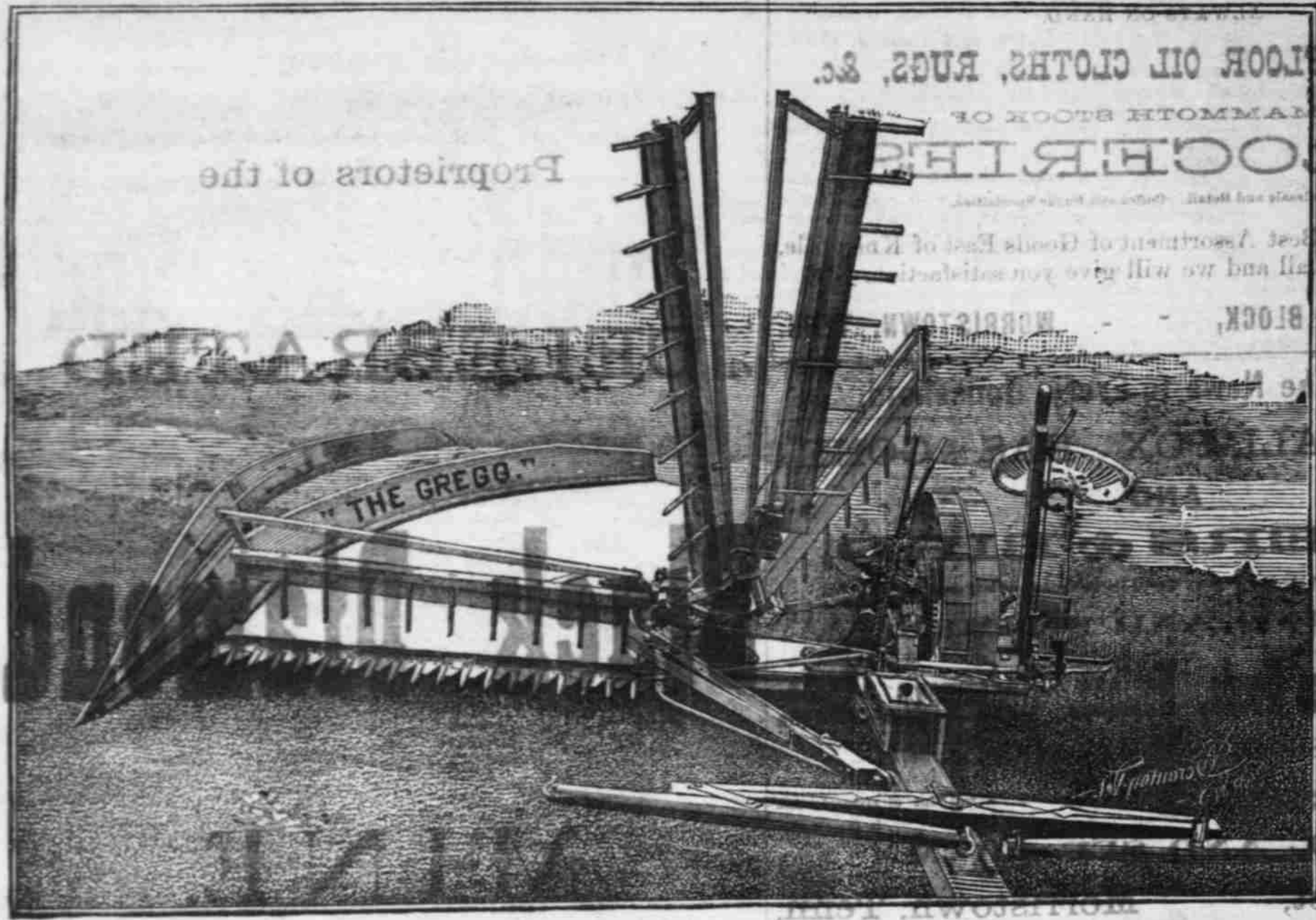

### THE GREGG SELF RAKE REAPER.

The Most Perfect Sweep Rake Reaper Built, and is the Lightest Draft Reaper in Use!

During the past three years the Gregg has been in the field under the personal supervision of ourselves, and after severe and thorough tests in all kinds of grain, we place it on the market positive in our confidence that it will meet the requirements of all sections of country.

I. The grain table of the machine can be tilted by means of a lever, within easy reach of his hand, enabling him to place the knives in position to reach grain in any condition.

II. The table may be elevated or lowered at the will of the driver.

III. The rakes are under absolute control of the operator, which enables him to operate his machine under all conditions to the best possible advantage by the use of the foot-trip, using them either as beaters or rakes. Large or small gavels can be made or the handle carried any distance on the platform, and by a simple or automatic attachment all or any of the rakes can be made to operate independently of the attention of the driver. These important features of controlling and operating the rakes are obtained by very simple arrangements that add no complication to the machinery.

IV. The frame and gearing so simplified that there is nothing cumbersome or strappy which can in any way interfere with its practical efficiency, and is amply protected by a shield covering it completely.

V. The finger-bar is made of cold-rolled Angle Iron, giving it four times the stiffness of ordinary flat bars, and at the same time is much lighter. The guards are malleable iron, steel plated. The crank-shaft is also of cold-rolled iron. All of the smaller parts of the machine are made of malleable iron, thus avoiding all chance of breakage. All material used in its manufacture is submitted to thorough inspection and test, which insures a durable implement.

#### ANY PLOW CAN BE USED.

It will plow as close to a fence, post or stump, as can be done by hand. Stone no obstacle. In story and hard land its advantages are most apparent, the principle upon which the plow is hung being calculated to force it into the ground, however hard.

#### The Plow is Handled by the Driver from His Seat.

by a simple system of levers, enabling him to control its operations with absolute certainty.

The vibrating frame to which the plow is attached is pivoted to the axle, and is so arranged as to be frictionless. The axle is adjustable, and can be raised, lowered or tipped in either direction at will, throwing the plow on the mould-board or land-side precisely as is done by hand, enabling the driver to regulate the depth and width of the furrow instantly. This is the only machine which permits these motions, and without them no plow sulky can succeed in doing good work.

IS UNEQUALED and is the only Rake that never binds in dumping.

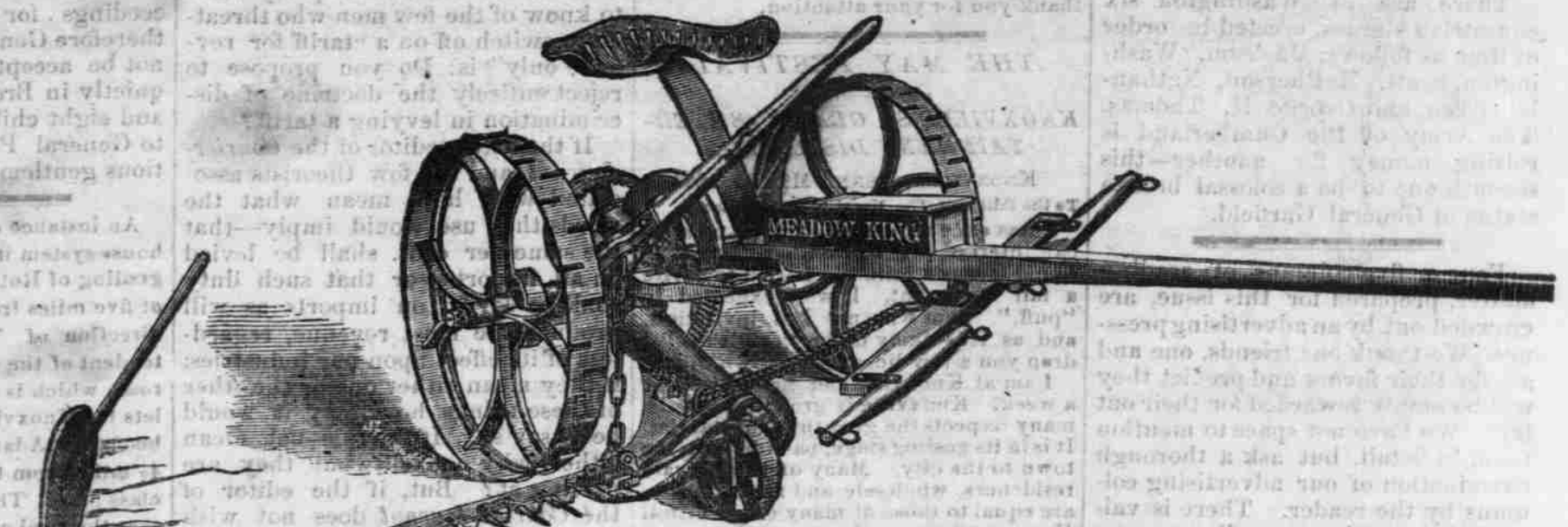
### THE GREGG RAKE.

Is the only COMPLETELY CONTROLLABLE SELF-DUMPING WHEEL RAKE in the market, operating without ratchets, gears or springs. It can be raised gradually to any height desired, carried any distance, raised entire, and dropped at any instant, which is the most desirable feature in a Self-Dumping Rake.

The self-dumping device has no lost motion; dumps from both wheels. Side draft impossible; 20 adjustable oil tempered Steel Teeth, each one left with its own weight to follow the surface, and each tooth a duplicate of the other.

"The Gregg" is placed on the market strictly on its merits.

This Rake is improved in the releasing attachment for the torsion clutch. This improvement is peculiar to the "Gregg" and is an essential feature, not possessed by any other Rake made.



### The Meadow King Mower.

The cutting apparatus is in front of the wheels, in full view of the driver, enabling him to see and avoid obstacles, removing the danger to life and limb by being thrown from his seat. The bar can be elevated to any angle from the seat with perfect ease, allowing the mower to be driven close to trees or rocks without throwing out of gear or stopping the team. The whiffletrees are suspended beneath the tongue, and are attached to the draft chain which passes through a loop on the main shoe to a hook on the shaft supporter near the axle. This reduces the draft, prevents the cutting apparatus from dropping into dead furrows or holes so suddenly as to unseat the driver or jar the machine. It also removes all side draft.

Similarity.—In this feature it has decided advantages over all others, having fewer parts and requiring no adjusting in the field, every machine being complete when it leaves the shop, with full directions for setting up, which operation is so simple that any one can do it with the tools accompanying the machine.

Every machine is provided with extra guards, sections, rivets, etc., wrench, cold chisels, etc., enclosed in a neat tool box attached to the tongue.

To sum up: We claim that for strength, durability, simplicity, ease of draft, and in all that goes to make up a mower machine, the MEADOW KING has no equal.
