Sec. 3.—It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to erect or continue or cause to be erected or continued any privy, hog-sty, cow-sty, stable or any other nuisance within the corporate limits of said village, so near to another lot as to injure the health or materially affect the comfort of any other person occupying such lot...

ORDINANCE XII

Sec. 23.—Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be liable to the President and Trustees of said Village to sue for the same, and to enforce the collection thereof...

ORDINANCE XXV

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 1.—The following boundaries shall constitute the fire limits of the Village of Paw Paw, viz: On each side of Main street, twelve rods deep between Niles and Griggs streets; on each side of Kalamazoo street, twelve rods deep between Paw Paw street and Oak street...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 2.—It shall not be lawful for any person to erect or place any building or part of any building, or make any repairs to or alteration of, or move any building within said fire limits, without having obtained from the President and Trustees a written permit therefor...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 3.—It shall not be lawful for any person to erect any building within the fire limits, unless the walls thereof be at least one-fourth of one inch thick, and the roof covered with slate, metal or gravel...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 4.—When any wooden building within said fire limits shall be partially destroyed by fire or other causes, such as become decayed, and the damage by fire or other destructive causes, or the cost of repairing such partially destroyed portion of a building, shall not, in the opinion of the committee on fire and water, exceed one-half of its actual value; it may be repaired, provided that such partially destroyed building is not nearer than twenty-five feet of any brick building...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 5.—It shall not be lawful for any person to erect or place any building, or part of any building, within thirty feet of the boundary line of the fire limits, except the outer walls and roof be constructed as provided for in section three of this ordinance...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 6.—Whenever in the opinion of the fire and water committee, any wall or other part of a burned building is dangerous, or when any building shall be deemed by them unsafe for the purposes for which it is used, or that shall be in danger of being set on fire from any defect in its construction, the chairman of said committee shall notify the owner, occupant or agent in charge of such building in writing, specifying wherein such danger consists, or wherein such building is unsafe or defective, and such owner, occupant or agent in charge of such building shall, upon receipt of such notice, forthwith proceed to pull down or secure such wall or dangerous parts thereof...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 7.—It shall be the duty of the committee on fire and water to examine all buildings within the fire limits, and said committee shall have the power to prevent the erection of any building which, in their judgment, is being constructed in an unsafe manner...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 8.—Whenever it shall be the duty of the committee on fire and water to declare any building unsafe, or to remove the same, or to remove any part of the same, they may deem necessary to enable them to determine whether any such building is unsafe and dangerous, and they shall make and keep a full record of their doings and the proceedings of the committee on fire and water...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 9.—In case said committee shall determine that any building is unsafe or dangerous, they shall report to the President and Trustees the result of their examination and determination, and cause a copy thereof to be made by the President and Trustees, and the same to be filed in the office of the President and Trustees, and said President and Trustees shall have power to direct such owner, occupant or agent in charge thereof for such owner, to put such building in a safe condition, or to remove the same, and shall do so at the time when the same shall be done...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 10.—In case the owner or occupant of any such building, or the agent in charge thereof for such owner, shall refuse to obey the order of said President and Trustees, it shall be the duty of the Marshal to cause such order to be executed, and the owner or occupant of such building shall be liable to pay the costs and expenses thereof, and in default of payment thereof, he shall be liable to the punishment hereinafter provided for in this ordinance...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 11.—Every chimney hereafter built or erected within the Village of Paw Paw, shall be so constructed as to admit of being scraped, brushed or cleaned...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 12.—No pipe of any stove within the fire limits of said Village shall be put up or used unless the same be conducted into a chimney made of brick or stone, nor shall any such pipe be put up so as to project through the chimney into the open air, and in all cases where a stove pipe passes through the roof of a building, it shall be separated from such wood-work, at least six inches, by sheet-iron or other incombustible material...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 13.—No ashes shall be kept or deposited in any place within the fire limits of the Village of Paw Paw, except in a close iron or other covered vessel, or brick or stone ash-house, thoroughly secured...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 14.—Nothing contained in the above ordinances relating to the fire limits of the Village of Paw Paw, shall be construed to prevent the construction of sheds for fuel and privies, or repairing the same, but no such shed or privy shall be constructed to exceed ten feet by twenty feet, or covering an area of 200 square feet, and not more than twelve feet high; neither shall they be used for other purposes than those above specified...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 15.—Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace of the Township of Paw Paw, shall be liable to the punishment hereinafter provided for in this ordinance, or may be imprisoned in the County Jail of Van Buren County for any period not exceeding ninety days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court...

RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAW PAW. Sec. 16.—Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before
