A BICYCLIST'S TRIP.

Thomas Stevens, the Tourist, in His Rambles About the Persian Capital—A City Full of Medicants.

Mr. Thomas Stevens, in a letter to the Boston *Herald* from Teheran, Persia, says:

Breakfast at noon, and a stroll through the top-maidan, or artillery square, is proposed and accepted. The thermometer, which registered 25 degrees above zero this morning at sunrise, now registers 50 in the shade, and the sun shines almost too warm to be comfortable. The ground has been freezing at night and thawing again during the day regularly since the snow-storm of a week ago, and the street we turn down is muddy. Through the mud, however, are foot-paths trodden sufficiently hard and dry by the broad-soled greivahs of hundreds of pedestrians and the spreading feet of strings of camels to enable us to pick our way without much discomfort.

"Sahib," he replied, "I have a family to support, and I can't afford to accept the position; I earn 30 kerans a month at begging." This man never, under any circumstances, solicits alms by word of mouth; his stock in trade is his appearance of respectable neediness, and a well-assumed expression of shamefacedness, as though ashamed to be obliged to subsist on charity. He isn't ashamed, though; a Persian doesn't know the sensation of shame; he is simply acting for the consideration of 30 kerans a month, which he obtains from passing foreigners, who toss him a coin occasionally as a reward for his seeming modesty and his unobtrusiveness, appreciating this in contrast to the numbers who incessantly worry them with their importunities.
