The effects of the organization will be directed towards securing the largest number of subscriptions rather than a small number of subscriptions in large amounts. The drive starts Monday, October 20, and closes on Monday, October 27th, the latter date being the anniversary of the birth of the man whose memory it is proposed to honor.
