PEI-HO VALLEY IS DEVASTATED

Nothing Left but Roofless Huts and Fallen Walls. LOOTING HAS BEEN COMPLETE.

Among the American Forces Alone Was Discipline Maintained in This Respect—Death by Starvation is Inevitable.

(By Associated Press.) TIEN TSI, August 26.—Military law still prevails in Tien Tsin and the city has as yet made no effort to recover from the terrible shock which it experienced. Everywhere is ruin. The land is devastated, villages wiped out, crops commensured or destroyed and the natives either hiding or killed.

Here the Russians and Japanese predominate. No one knows the total strength of either force, but they run into the thousands. Skirting the river on either bank, the Russian camps dot the country. The Russian flag flies from the railway stations, and Russian troops are continually passing along the roads, either moving on towards Peking or establishing advanced outposts.

Meanwhile the American and British forces are quiescent in camp, and do not seem inclined to press matters, now that the legations are safe. The American force at Tien Tsin is composed of the Fifteenth Infantry, the ranking American officer in the absence of General Chaffee, and his headquarters are in the home of a wealthy Chinaman who is also an undertaker.

The marine corps has fared better. Like the Europeans and English troops the sea soldiers are quartered in airy, comfortable buildings in the English concessions. The men occupy several large structures with big courts and comfortable quarters.

The Americans, without exception, are behaving splendidly, and their officers have been much complimented on the discipline and police of their forces. No grave charges have been brought against them, and in the loot they do not seem to have been in the same class with the others, especially the Russians.

The big shells from the forts swept down the Victoria road, flew over the river and left devastation in their path. Grim, desolate, blackened walls are all that is left of the once beautiful section. The stands in ruined gardens and blasted trees keep guard over shapeless piles of debris.

It is impossible to convey an idea of the ruins in the native city. The thatched roofs burned fiercely and the mud and shingles shivered at the impact of the shells. Probably no accurate estimate of the loss of life in this densely populated section will ever be made.

Naturally food of all kinds is scarce. A little produce is finding its way into the city, some sheep have arrived and milk is being obtained, but the fare, at best, is hard, and everything is at war-time prices.
