French Peasants Have Very Successful Crop Year in Devastated Regions of France.

This year's crops in the invaded regions of France will exceed pre-war production. A cable received today by the French Commission in the United States says:

READ CAREFULLY Why Should Tobacco Be Graded By the Growers at Home?

WHY SHOULD TOBACCO BE GRADED BY THE GROWERS AT HOME? FIRST—Because the Warehousemen cannot get enough experienced Tobacco men, they have to employ men who work at other trades, such as Carpenters, Painters and Engineers for nine months in the year and never see tobacco until it comes on the Warehouse floor.

Official figures show the remarkable results in agriculture accomplished since the armistice. Of 1,757,777 hectares to be reconditioned, 1,619,902 hectares had been levelled and cleared of debris by September 1st while on the same date 1,197,704 hectares had received their first plowing.

Dr. John Orlin Hibben, President of Princeton University:—"I heartily approve of the plan to hold a conference in Washington of the representatives of the various patriotic and civic organizations of our country to consider definite plans for co-ordinated work in reference to the all important subject of co-ordination. The co-ordination of all of these activities would prove, in my opinion, of inestimable advantage to the cause."

The New Jersey legislature has passed a bill limiting the hours of employment of women in factories and providing a heavy penalty for employers violating the law.

Dr. Arthur T. Hadley, President of Yale University:—"I am heartily glad that a co-operative movement in behalf of Americanization is being arranged. Our great trouble at the present day is that we have too many organizations for the same purpose. A small group of people who can give their time, acting under the chairmanship of a capable man, does better in the direction of general activity than twenty different organizations. I feel that this will be conspicuously true in the matter of Americanization."
