AN ADD-ESS To the Honest Voters of Ohio and the Country,

BY THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE. How the State Was Carried. THE DUTY OF THE DEMOCRACY.

HEADQUARTERS STATE DEM. EX. COM. Columbus, Ohio, October 18, 1884. To the Honest and True Patriots of Ohio and of the United States:

The result of the election in Ohio last Tuesday for State officers should arouse every citizen who loves his country, to a realizing sense of the dangers that menace our free institutions.

A million dollars raised by wealthy stock jobbers and monopolists, was sent into the state. With it came the scum of the country, thieves, ex-detectives, repeaters and governmental officials, headed by W. W. Dudley, Chief of the Pension Bureau.

In addition, two thousand men, many of them outlaws and desperate characters, and but few of them citizens of Ohio, were sworn in as Deputy U. S. Marshals in Cincinnati. Armed with weapons purchased by the corrupt fund furnished by Dudley and his gang, they surrounded the polls in that city, voted where they pleased, bulldozed, beat and shed blood at pleasure, interfering with our citizens in the discharge of their most sacred duties.

The enumeration of male inhabitants in 1880 shows that 66,298 adult males, of which number 1,683 were colored, and yet over 72,000 votes were polled at the election in that city. The enumeration taken in that city, included all persons over the age of 21 years, whether they were naturalized citizens or not.

On the day following the election the Republican Committee of Ohio, with a reckless disregard for truth, and imitating the example of their illustrious chief, caused to be spread broadcast over the country that they had carried Ohio by 25,000 majority. For political effect they were willing to exaggerate and lie. We feel it our duty to lay these facts before the people of the country.

The result of this election in Ohio need not discourage Democrats here or elsewhere, but, considering the fearful odds against us, and the fact that we are outnumbered and will be outnumbered, it is our duty to continue the fight. The battle has just begun. The men, the money, the methods which gave the Republicans their wholly and discreditable victory in Ohio, must be met by us.

We can yet remove the stain that has been cast on the fair name of Ohio by the corruptists and carry the State for an honest man and President.
