PEOPLE travel economically in England. On the London and North-western railway during the six months ending with June, 1896, 25,135,651 passengers were carried. Of these 25,457,620 travelled third-class, 1,681,401 second-class and 986,592 first-class. The same proportions characterize the travel on all the other roads.

The great Hudson river bridge to be built at Poughkeepsie will contain the longest truss spans and largest cantilevers in the world, and the height to which the structure will be taken is unexampled, except in a few isolated cases where chasms or canyons have been spanned, without the necessity for intermediate construction from the piers below.

THE warning of physicians to-day is uttered against the neglect of physical exercise by American women. It is this neglect which causes half the maladies of women, makes them old before middle age, and produces a deteriorating effect upon the race. It prevails especially among the well-to-do and wealthy classes, where there is less excuse for it than among the poor.

THE Supreme Court of the United States, in a series of test cases against the Pacific National Bank of Boston, whose capital stock had increased nearly a half-million dollars, holds that each stock-holder is as liable for the full amount of the watered stock which he possesses as if he had purchased it originally. The reasoning which led up to this conclusion will be of interest to lawyers, as well as to the holders of bank stocks.

CLOSE on the heels of the discovery of artificial quinine at six cents an ounce comes the announcement that artificial rubies are now being made which are identical in chemical constitution with the real stone and only distinguishable by the severest tests. The rubies rank with the diamond, sapphire and emerald as among the most costly of precious stones, and though an artificial diamond has never been made, imitations abound which deceive all but experts.

A SOCIETY for the prevention of hydrophobia has been started in London. The organization does not propose to wait for the dogs to bite before they apply the remedy, but rather to apply it to the dogs themselves, by killing them off before they go mad. They take the ground that populous cities are not the places for dogs, that it is injurious to the animal and dangerous to man, and that it is better to dispatch the dogs than have the people infected with hydrophobia.

THE shocking railway accident in Wisconsin, which resulted in the literal roasting of not less than twenty human beings, again calls public attention to the fact that with all the progress made in the comforts and conveniences of modern railway traveling, no one has yet invented a car that will not burn, nor have railway companies, as a rule, gone beyond the coal stove and the oil lamp as means of heating and lighting passenger cars. For more than a quarter of a century wrecked trains have become funeral pyres.

INSULATED drop lines for sending messages to different parts of the battle field is the latest innovation in the art of war. To lay and operate such lines the German War Office has just detailed two hundred sub-officers of the army to study telegraphy. Aids and orderlies dashing hither and yon on foot-fleeced chargers will hereafter be part of the superfluous pomp of war. Electricity, speeding along a little insulated, trailed line of wire, will put the whole field of combat under instant command of the general commanding.

THERE is a popular misapprehension concerning the Liberty statue. People think they will be able to ride in elevators or to climb spiral stairways to the gallery around the torch or the crown upon the goddess' head. It is not intended, though, that any visitor shall at any time ascend higher than the pedestal; but in order that every part of the statue may be reached for repairs, narrow iron stairs, smaller than those used in fire-escapes, have been placed within the frame-work, and make the highest points of the work accessible.
