The Union Republican State Convention will be held at Columbus, on Wednesday, the 23rd day of June, 1869, for the nomination of candidates for the following offices, viz: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Judge of the Supreme Court, Treasurer of State, Member of Board of Public Works.
