Passed at the Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1884. CHAPTER 27. AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Westminster to issue its Bonds or Certificates of Indebtedness...

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Westminster be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to issue its Bonds or Certificates of Indebtedness...
