

PUBLIC LOCAL LAW

Passed at the Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1884.

CHAPTER 227.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Westminster to issue its Bonds or Certificates of Indebtedness to an amount not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, for the purpose of providing means for the Grading, Paving, and Macadamizing of the Streets in the City of Westminster and the Construction of Sewers.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to issue Bonds in the name of the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster, in sums not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, for the purpose of providing means for the Grading, Paving, and Macadamizing of the Streets in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Construction of Sewers, in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Grading, Paving, and Macadamizing of the Streets in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Construction of Sewers, in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars.

Section 2. And be it enacted, That the said Bonds shall be issued payable twenty years from the date thereof, and redeemable at any time after the expiration of ten years from the date thereof, at the pleasure of the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Grading, Paving, and Macadamizing of the Streets in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Construction of Sewers, in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars.

Section 3. And be it enacted, That the said Bonds shall be issued payable twenty years from the date thereof, and redeemable at any time after the expiration of ten years from the date thereof, at the pleasure of the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Grading, Paving, and Macadamizing of the Streets in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, and for the purpose of providing means for the Construction of Sewers, in the City of Westminster, not exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars.

Section 4. Section 5. Section 7.
