### CONGRESSMAN CUMMINGS ON MR. GOR- MAN FOR PRESIDENT.

From the New York Journal.

Backbone ought to be the first requisite for a candidate for the Presidency. It should be an excellent judge of men—strong, and not a talker. With a clear perception of the duties of his office, he should have the nerve to perform them manfully and without favor. Ambition, industry, energy, integrity, reflection, good judgment, tact, impassiveness, patriotism, fair play of opinion, party loyalty, true Democracy and real manhood are prerequisites. Remembering that the power of the President is limited by the Constitution, he should never overstep its bounds. Standing firmly upon the rights of the executive branch of government, he should never trespass upon those of the legislative and judicial branches. A well-seasoned statesman ought to mix a good deal of common sense with the laws of the Constitution. He ought to warn and not chill his countrymen.

All these traits are to be found in Arthur P. Gorman, of Maryland. He was 60 years old on March 11 last. Forty-seven of these 60 years have been passed in the public service. When 15 years old he was made a page in the Senate of the United States. It was Stephen A. Douglas who placed him upon this lowest rung of the political ladder.

Gorman was afterward postmaster of the Senate, Collector of Internal Revenue, a member of the House of Delegates of the Maryland Legislature, Speaker of the House, State Senator, and finally, on March 4, 1881, became a United States Senator. Certainly no man of his age in the United States has had equal experience in legislation and in the executive departments of the Government. Aside from the fact that he has shown rare political sagacity, as true as steel to his friends, he fights his enemies right royally. There is a manliness about him that has drawn the attention of the whole country. He has optics in a Democracy, and one without a tinge of unpopularity. Never has he swerved from the party line.
