In accordance with the act of Congress, the census of the population and farms of the United States will begin on April 15, 1910.

Many of the questions which will be asked you concerning the equipment and operations of your farm can be accurately answered by you without considerable thought and the making of careful calculations or estimates.

Read the instructions carefully, to write down the answers to all questions that apply to your farm, and to keep it until the enumerator comes.

By doing this you can save yourself much time and contribute greatly to the success of the agricultural census.


