VALUE OF FIELD PRODUCTS.

The value of field products in the United States has almost doubled since 1899, according to statistics prepared by the Department of Agriculture.

Illinois is the first State in the union in the value of its field crops. Texas is second, Iowa third, Kansas fourth and Missouri fifth.

The crops that are included in the computation are corn, wheat, oats, barley, rye, buckwheat, flaxseed, rice, potatoes, hay, cotton and tobacco.

LETTER FROM HOT SPRINGS.

GOVERNMENT RECEIVES \$60 PER YEAR FOR EVERY BATH TUB.

Cannot Make Suds or Lather of Water—Everybody has a Drinking Cup—Consumptives Cannot Be Treated—Two Murders and a Suicide.

For the Advocate, Dear Mr. Editor: Thinking that some of the readers of the Advocate and friends of mine would like to hear something about Hot Springs, I will endeavor to give them an outline and description of the place as I see and learn.

The city of Hot Springs is sloped like a funnel and the neck of the funnel is the interesting part here. The main thoroughfare is called Central Avenue.

There are about forty-seven hot springs located on the reservation some visible others not. They supply the bath houses and the fountains that the people drink so much of.

The bath houses are wooden cottage style, with nice reception room in front where people rest before and after bathing.

The government gets sixty dollars per year for every tub that is in the buildings. As I said in the Sentinel letter, people are here from every one of at least thirty states.

Consumption and heart trouble cannot be treated here, at least they cannot take the baths, outside of those troubles, people are here for everything, and the majority of them get benefited.

I get both papers from home and see that everything is moving along as usual, that some are sick, some have died and some coming and going to the hospitals.
